

PECO Energy Company ("PECO Energy"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.61, responds to the Complaint and states:

1. Admitted.

4. Admitted in part and denied in part. PECO Energy admits when Complainant

applied for service at 1115 Maplecrest Cr., Gladwyne, on or about May, 2005, her credit history included an unpaid account balance for services rendered from November, 1999 to December, 1999. PECO Energy specifically denies incorrectly billing Complainant a deposit pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 56.32.


On May 19, 2005, Complainant was charged a security deposit in the amount of \$514.00 in three installments. The first installment of \$257.00 was billed to the account on June 7, 2005; the remainder of the deposit was subsequently billed in two installments of \$128.50.

The Bureau of Consumer Services ("BCS") rendered a decision on March 29, 2006. The BCS found that PECO Energy was permitted to charge a deposit on Complainant's account. A copy of the decision is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

5. This paragraph is a request for relief and no answer is required.
6. PECO Energy is without sufficient information to confirm or deny this statement.
7. Admitted.

WHEREFORE, PECO Energy Company respectfully requests that your Honorable Commission dismiss the instant Complaint.



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
