**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR MODIFICATION
OF THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE EMBER S. JANDEBEUR:

AND NOW comes PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric”) and files this Motion for Modification of the Procedural Schedule pursuant to Section 5.103 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 5.103. PPL Electric is authorized by counsel for A. Edward Schwartz (“Complainant”) to represent that Complainant does not oppose this request. In support thereof, PPL Electric states as follows:

1. On July 18, 2013, Complainant filed a Formal Complaint with the Commission against PPL Electric. Complaint’s claims relate to the operation of certain solar generating facilities on his property in Berks County, Pennsylvania, and the interconnection between his system and PPL Electric’s distribution system.

2. PPL Electric filed its Answer to the Complaint on August 14, 2013. In its Answer, PPL Electric denied the Complainant’s allegations.

3. On July 15, 2015, Administrative Law Judge Ember S. Jandebaur (the “ALJ”) issued an Initial Hearing Notice, wherein the ALJ set an initial hearing for September 2, 2015.

4. On August 4, 2015, PPL Electric filed a Request for Relief asking that the hearing scheduled for September 2, 2015 be converted to a prehearing conference, which was granted by the ALJ.

5. A prehearing conference was held on September 2, 2015 at which time the parties agreed to a procedural schedule.

6. Pursuant to the procedural schedule, the Complainant served Direct Testimony on October 9, 2015.

7. On October 14, 2015, PPL Electric served a set of interrogatories on the Complainant which addressed claims and assertions made in his testimony filed on October 9, 2015. Under the procedural rules agreed to at the pre-hearing conference, the responses were due on October 26, 2015, in time to be incorporated into PPL Electric's testimony, which is due on October 30, 2015.

8. On October 16, 2015, the ALJ issued a Rescheduling Order maintaining the remaining filing dates for testimony, but rescheduling the Initial Hearing for December 1, 2015.

9. On October 27, 2015, counsel for PPL Electric contacted counsel for the Complainant regarding the outstanding discovery responses that were due on October 26, 2015. Counsel for the Complainant advised PPL Electric that, due to a number of intervening circumstances, the earliest the responses would be available is October 30, 2015.

13. The parties have mutually agreed that an extension of three business days for PPL Electric's testimony due date is appropriate, in order to allow PPL Electric to avoid any potential prejudice and to avoid a discovery dispute. With the extension, PPL Electric's testimony will be due on November 4, 2015.

14. In order to provide the Complainant with sufficient time to review PPL Electric's testimony and prepare his responsive testimony, the parties have also agreed that it would be


appropriate to provide the same extension to the Complainant. Therefore, Complainant's testimony, which is currently due on November 13, 2015, would be due on November 18, 2015.

15. This request does not impact the evidentiary hearing date, which will remain as December 1, 2015. All subsequent dates in the procedural schedule will remain as established in the Order issued on October 16, 2015.

WHEREFORE, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation respectfully requests that the unopposed modification to the procedural schedule, to allow for testimony to be filed on November 4, 2015 for PPL Electric and November 18, 2015 for the Complainant, be granted.
