In re: Verified request of Sinclair Moving & Storage, Inc.
for authority as a motor common carrier of
property, excluding household goods in use, between
points in Pennsylvania.

Dear Mr. Reeves:

Your client's request has been received and reviewed. A
request for property authority is no longer necessary.

As you are aware, the Commission's Final Decision on Regulation
of Motor Common Carriers of Property at P-00940884, (order adopted
December 15, 1994; order entered December 20, 1994), adopted the Interstate
Commerce Commission's definition of household goods which contains three
provisos.

The I.C.C. Termination Act of 1995 eliminated the second and
third proviso from the household goods definition. The second and third
provisos, in effect, have become a part of the property definition. As a
result, any household goods carrier holding household goods authority prior
to January 1, 1996, now also holds authority:

To transport, as a motor common carrier of property, excluding
household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania.

Any authority held is subject to current insurance being on
file.
