On June 29, 1998, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety instituted a complaint against Roger L. Palmer, respondent, alleging failure to maintain proper evidence of current insurance in violation of the Public Utility Code. The respondent was duly notified that if acceptable evidence of insurance or an answer was not filed, the Bureau would request that the Secretary of the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued to the respondent at A-00111140.

The complaint and notice were served on the respondent on July 3, 1998; to date, more than twenty (20) days later, neither evidence of insurance nor an answer to the complaint has been filed. Therefore, the allegation in the complaint is deemed to be admitted.

The complaint at A-00111140C9801 is hereby sustained and the certificate of public convenience issued to the respondent at A-00111140 is hereby revoked. The respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from providing service previously authorized under the certificate of public convenience.
