## Response to Objections

l) Since National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation CONVEYED the well and lease to Seneca Resources Corporation in 1994, Seneca Resources Corporation all agreements made between National Fuel Gas and the Wiser family. The term to convey means to assign a complete transfer of the original agreement of 1914. Therefore, Seneca Resources Corporation holds complete responsibility for the well.

g) Seneca Resources assumed all that was agreed upon between National Fuel Gas Corporation, a public utility, and the Wiser family.

m) We are sending cancelled checks written by my wife, Shari Wiser (Dolmovich) during the time in question(1975) to 1990. I have spoken to Jeannine M. Bacher, Land Services Manager for National Fuel Gas. Using the account number 146215-3031-0(on check number 137), She was able to find the account belonging to Richard and Shari Dolmovich during the time in question.

d) cancelled checks are being sent.

a) Shari Dolmovich(Wiser) should have been included in the original complaint. Ronald Wiser is Shari Wiser's husband.

e) We are sending pictures of the well in question, well #3951, These pictures will show new piping, check valves, and new equipment replaced on the well in question. I observed the well in use in January, 2015, during the coldest part of last winter.

g) The Wiser's spoke to MR. Colmerauer about possibly purchasing the well. Our attorney, LaVita Lerch, Esquire, drafted a letter to Mr. Colmerauer, expressing our desire to have the well checked by a professional well operator and possibly to purchase the well. Mr Colmerauer indicated that the well has mechanical problems, not gas pressure problems. This is the first and only mention of mechanical problems within the well, but he indicated sufficient pressure was in the well.

k) The Wisers would like to have the pressure in the well checked by an independent gas contractor.

10) The Wisers requested repayment of gas bills in 1990. I Ronald Wiser, spoke the Erie office after Shari and I were married and National Fuel Gas gave us a free gas account. The Field manager, Ms. Huffman, agreed that we could apply for reimbursement, but by doing so we might affect the status of the well. She suggested that we wait until a further date.

Both Shari and I believe that we are being wronged by Seneca Resources Corporation and are requesting a settlement in our favor. If the PUC does not have the authority to rule, please advise us about the next legal step.

This letter is a response to your letter of May 26, 2015 wherein you informed me that your clients, the Wisers, were interested in purchasing the above referenced well. I have spoken to Mr. Wisner previously but I never indicated that we were willing to sell the well to him and his wife. In fact I told him that we were planning to plug the well and that we would not be able to sell the well due to mechanical problems that the well has. I did tell him that I would confirm the status of the well with one of our production people.

Please be advised that I have recently spoken with one of our Senior Production Foremen and have confirmed that the well does have mechanical problems that will prohibit us from selling the well to the Wisers. We will proceed with our plugging plans and it should be noted as has previously been communicated, that the free gas arrangement will be terminated on or about July 15, 2015.


Dear Mr. and Mrs. Wiser:

I write in response to your letter received August 26, 2015 and our recent telephone conversation. National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation was the operator of the well and lease during the period of time between the years of 1974 to 1994. Prior to 1974, the well and lease was operated by United Natural Gas Company. United Natural Gas Company changed its name to National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation. In 1994 the well and lease was conveyed to Empire Exploration, Inc. now known as Seneca Resources Corporation. All questions and concerns you have regarding the well and lease since 1994 should be addressed to Seneca Resources Corporation.

Concerning your inquiry regarding the use of the "free gas" during the ownership period of Richard and Shari Dolmovich that does fall within the period of time National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation owned and operated the well and lease, we disagree that it was an "error" that during that period of time, Richard and Shari Dolmovich did not receive the "free gas" and instead purchased and paid for the natural gas consumed. National Fuel Gas Supply Corporation cannot now reimburse for the "free gas" that was not used during that period of time.

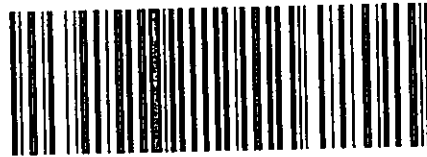
