
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On November 11, 2015, PECO Energy received the Complainant, Mary Gillespie's request to withdraw the above-referenced matter. Enclosed is a copy of Ms. Gillespie's correspondence, requesting withdrawal of the formal complaint. 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a) states:

Except as provided in subsection (b), a party desiring to withdraw a pleading in a contested proceeding may file a petition for leave to withdraw the appropriate document with the Commission and serve it upon the other parties. The petition must set forth the reasons for the withdrawal. A party may object to the petition within 20 days of service. After considering the petition, an objection thereto and the public interest, the presiding officer or the Commission will determine whether the withdrawal will be permitted.



To Those Whom It May Concern:

RE: REVISED SUBMISSION

I am contacting you because I was apparently given the wrong information in order to request a meeting with PECO regarding the unwanted replacement of my current, well-functioning electric meter.

My intention was/is to discuss this matter with an authorized and knowledgeable PECO or PUC engineer or person familiar with the widely-publicized problems with the replacement meters. I was told that the only way to connect with someone other than your front-line telephone operators was to send you a complaint letter. By mailing that Complaint Letter as I was told, this resulted in an unexpected, undesired result.

I cannot find another form on the PECO website to use to request a meeting with a knowledgeable, authorized PECO engineer or other qualified employee. I had/have no intention of becoming involved in a lawsuit. I wish to discuss my deep concerns as they relate to my personal, physical and medical safety, to my unfortunate disability, and to the mandatory safety of my home and property.

If you have some form other than the one I inadvertently sent you, please forward it to me. I cannot find anything online.

Please disregard and retract the formal Complaint letter as I wish to dismiss any legal status which the letter may have entailed. Simply, as requested above, I wish to speak with a PECO person as described above, regarding the request to replace my currently well-functioning electric meter.


