Application of Adam's Moving & Hauling, Inc., a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for amendment to its common carrier certificate, which grants the right, to transport, by motor vehicle, household goods in use, between points in the city and county of Philadelphia, the city (sic) of Norristown, Montgomery County and within an airline distance of five (5) statute miles of the limits of said city, and Lower Merion Township, Montgomery County, and from points in said territory, to points in Pennsylvania; subject to the following conditions: (1) that no right is granted to provide service to points in DOCUMENT FOLDER the county of Centre and those points in other counties lying within an airline distance of twelve (12) miles of the limits of the borough of State College, Centre County; and (2) that no right is granted to perform service for Avtex Fibers Lewistown, Inc., Lewistown Hospital, Geisinger Medical Group and the Central Pennsylvania Conference of the United Methodist Church, to points in the county of Mifflin: SO AS TO PERMIT the transportation of household goods, in use, (1) between points in the counties of Chester, Delaware, and Montgomery that are located within an airline distance of ten (10) statute miles of the limits of the borough of Norristown, Montgomery County, and from said territory, to points in Pennsylvania; and (2) between points in the counties of Bucks and Montgomery that are located within an airline distance of seven (7) statute miles of the city and county of Philadelphia, and from said territory, to points in Pennsylvania.

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application filed March 10, 1998. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of March 21, 1998. Six (6) protests were filed by the above-mentioned carriers.

On the day preceding the prehearing conference all protests were withdrawn upon reconsideration and without restirctive amendment.

The now unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing. The record consists of the verified statements entered by the applicant and fourteen (14) individuals in support.

After complete review of the record, we find:

- 1. Applicant seeks to amend its common carrier household goods in use authority.
- 2. The application was protested by six (6) carriers; all protests were withdrawn upon reconsideration and without restrictive amendment.
- 3. The applicant has the equipment, experience, ability and fitness necessary to render the service.
- 4. The application is supported by fourteen (14) individuals attesting to a need for the service.
 - 5. The evidence of record is sufficient to establish necessity for the service.
- 6. Approval of the application is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; **THEREFORE**,

IT IS ORDERED: That the authority granted under the certificate issued June 17, 1998, be amended to include the following right:

To transport, as a common carrier, household goods, in use:

- (1) between points in the counties of Chester, Delaware and Montgomery that are located within an airline distance of ten (10) statute miles of the limits of the borough of Norristown, Montgomery County, and from said territory, to points in Pennsylvania; and
- (2) between points in the counties of Bucks and Montgomery that are located within an airline distance of seven (7) statute miles of the city and county of Philadelphia, and from said territory, to points in Pennsylvania.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation authorized by this order until the following is submitted to the Commission:

1. A tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the applicant, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.
