1 ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE CHARLES E. RAINEY,  
2 JR.: Good morning. My name is Charles Rainey and I  
3 am the Administrative Law Judge who has been assigned  
4 to this case and this is the case of the Application  
5 of Adam's Moving and Hauling, Incorporated at Docket  
6 Number A-00112192F0001 AmA.

7 I note for the record the appearance of  
8 Richard T. Mulcahey, Junior, Esquire, on behalf of  
9 Adam's Moving and Hauling, Incorporated. This was  
10 originally scheduled to be a hearing, however, it was  
11 changed to a prehearing conference at the request of  
12 the applicant.

13 I understand from a conversation with the  
14 applicant's attorney this morning, Mr. Mulcahey, that  
15 there has been a new development in this case. Mr.  
16 Mulcahey, why don't you state for the record what the  
17 present status of this matter is?

18 MR. MULCAHEY: Good morning, Your Honor.

19 JUDGE RAINEY: Good morning.

20 MR. MULCAHEY: Yesterday I received a  
21 voice-mail message from William Casey who represents  
22 the protestants in the case, I believe there are six  
23 protestants, indicating that after further  
24 consideration, they had decided to withdraw their  
25 protest to the case and he said that he would ask me

1 to represent that to Your Honor and apologize that it  
2 was such a late time.

3 Unfortunately, I only confirmed that by  
4 talking to him this morning at about 8:30 and by the  
5 time I reached Your Honor, it was too late to cancel  
6 the hearing. I certainly apologize for that, as  
7 well.

8 That being the case, Your Honor, I would  
9 request that this matter be transferred to the Bureau  
10 of Transportation under the Commission's modified  
11 procedure to provide along those guidelines.

12 JUDGE RAINEY: I think that would be an  
13 order. Let me just note for the record that there  
14 are six protestants who are represented by Mr. Casey,  
15 those protestants being: One, Clemmer Moving &  
16 Storage, Inc.; two, Dillon Moving, Incorporated;  
17 three, Morgan Moving and Storage Limited; four,  
18 O'Brien's Moving and Storage, Incorporated; five,  
19 Read's Van Service, Incorporated, and six, Shelly  
20 Moving and Storage, Incorporated.

21 MR. MULCAHEY: Your Honor, to be fair to Mr.  
22 Casey --

23 JUDGE RAINEY: Sure.

24 MR. MULCAHEY: -- he mentioned to me that it  
25 was difficult contacting six clients and getting them

1 to agree to anything, let alone withdrawing.

2 JUDGE RAINEY: Yes.

3 MR. MULCAHEY: So that was the cause for the  
4 delay. But both of us had anticipated that this  
5 would happen and that's why we requested this hearing  
6 to be a prehearing conference. Unfortunately, we  
7 couldn't cancel it on a timely basis.

8 JUDGE RAINEY: Thank you for that apology and  
9 representation. It's my understanding that there are  
10 no other protests to the application?

11 MR. MULCAHEY: That's correct, Your Honor.

12 JUDGE RAINEY: I will assume that Mr. Casey  
13 will file his withdraw of the protest to the  
14 application pursuant to 52 PA Code, Section 5.94 B  
15 and that withdrawal should be filed with the  
16 Commission with a copy to myself.

17 Also, this matter may be transferred to the  
18 Commission's technical staff in the Bureau of  
19 Transportation and Safety to consider the application  
20 under modified procedures appearing at 52 PA Code,  
21 Section 3.381 C iii and the three is represented by  
22 lower case Roman numerals, A and that's a capital A.  
23 Is there anything further which we need to take up,  
24 Mr. Mulcahey?

25 MR. MULCAHEY: No, Your Honor.

1 JUDGE RAINEY: If not, thank you very much  
2 for your appearance here today.

3 MR. MULCAHEY: Thank you, Your Honor.

4 JUDGE RAINEY: This prehearing is adjourned.
