

**STIPULATION OF WHEMCO –STEEL CASTINGS, INC.
AND DUQUESNE LIGHT COMPANY**

WHEMCO-Steel Castings, Inc. (“Whemco”) and Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne”), pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.234 stipulate and agree as follows:

1. On November 3, 2015, Duquesne filed with the Commission in the above-referenced proceeding an Application for Authorization to Take the Deposition of Pamela C. Polacek, Esquire, a Non-Party, and the Issuance of a Subpoena in Connection Therewith (“Application”).

2. Whemco has not filed an Answer or other pleading in response to the Application.

3. Whemco and Duquesne are collectively referred to herein as the “Parties.”

4. The Application shall be held in abeyance (and not decided by the presiding Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”)) under the terms specified herein, and Whemco shall not be required or have any obligation to file an Answer or other pleading in response to the Application, except as specified in this Stipulation.

5. If, after Whemco files its direct testimony in this proceeding, Duquesne advises Whemco in writing that Duquesne intends to pursue the relief requested in the Application, Whemco shall file an Answer or other pleading responding to the Application not later than ten (10) days after receipt of the aforesaid written notice from Duquesne.

6. Furthermore, in the event the presiding ALJ allows Duquesne to depose Ms. Polacek, over any objections that may be filed, or Whemco agrees to voluntarily allow Ms. Polacek to be deposed, Whemco and Duquesne will agree to a mutually acceptable date (subject to Ms. Polacek's approval and schedule) for the deposition of Ms. Polacek, within approximately two (2) weeks of the presiding ALJ ordering the deposition or Whemco notifying Duquesne that it has no opposition to Ms. Polacek's deposition.

7. Duquesne will not be required to file its direct testimony in this proceeding until one (1) month after all discovery and deposition issues, including discovery and depositions of other Whemco witnesses, are resolved to Duquesne's reasonable satisfaction or through resolution by the ALJ.

8. The Parties acknowledge and agree that this Stipulation is intended to be submitted to the presiding ALJ, filed with the Commission and the terms hereof will be reflected in an interim order to be issued by the ALJ in the above-captioned proceeding.

9. The terms and conditions of this Stipulation are true and correct and accurately embody the Parties' agreement in connection with the matters addressed herein.

10. The Parties shall implement all provisions of this Stipulation in good faith and in a timely manner.


11. The Parties, by their duly authorized counsel, agree to be bound to the terms and conditions hereof in their entirety, subject to any order that may be issued by the presiding ALJ in this proceeding.

12. This Stipulation may be executed in counterparts and, if so executed, the document shall constitute a single integrated agreement/stipulation between the Parties.




