A G R E E M E N T

THIS AGREEMENT made this 8 day of May, 1992, by and between DOMENIC CRISTINZIO, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Transferor") and TAD'S DELIVERY SERVICE, Inc., t/a- T&N Van Service, (hereinafter referred to as "Transferee").

W I T N E S S E T H:

1. Transferor agrees to sell and transfer unto Transferee those rights granted to it by the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission under Docket No. A-00086551 F.2 being more particularly set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. Transferee agrees to pay the Transferor as consideration for said rights the sum of FIVE THOUSAND AND 00/100 (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS. The consideration for said transfer shall be paid in full to Transferor, subject to and upon the approval of the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission and upon Transferor's tender of the rights at the time of settlement to take place at a reasonable period of time after the approval.

3. The parties hereto agree to the following miscellaneous provisions:

a. The cost of transfer and the processing of the transfer of said rights through the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission shall be borne by the Transferee;

b. This agreement shall be binding upon and enure to the benefit of the res



assigns, heirs and personal representatives;

c. Neither this Agreement nor any term or provision hereof may be changed, waived, discharged or terminated orally, or in any manner other than an instrument in writing signed by the parties hereto;

d. This contract shall be construed under and governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

4. The parties hereto shall do all things required to complete and file with the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission the Application for the approval of the transfer of the right described herein and shall do all things which may be required for the expeditious processing of the Application.

5. Transferor agrees to hold Transferee free and harmless from any and all liabilities of any nature whatsoever against the Transferee and agrees to file such reports as may be required by the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission with reference to the operations conducted by the Transferor up to the time of settlement. Transferee further agrees to pay any assessments which may be made by any agency by reason of operations conducted by Transferor up to the date of settlement. If Transferee pays such assessments by reason of assumption of said obligations, then in such event Transferor shall reimburse Transferee for such payment upon written demand, if Transferee shall make a demand.

6. Settlement shall be made at the office of Donald M. Davis, Esquire or at some other place as the parties shall agree within ten (10) days after the final approval of the said transfer by the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission.

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on a Petition for Reconsideration filed by Dominic Cristinzio, Inc. (Petitioner) on July 9, 1984. Petitioner seeks reconsideration of the conversion of its application for contract carrier authority to an application for common carrier authority.

On October 17, 1983, Petitioner filed an application for authority as follows:

"To transport, as a contract carrier, business and office machines, electronic manufacturing systems, parts and supplies thereof, manufactured, sold, leased, distributed or dealt in by International Business Machines Corporation (IBM)"



between points in several specified central and southeastern counties of Pennsylvania.

In December, 1983, counsel for Petitioner was advised that since Petitioner was an existing common carrier, the application would be modified and published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin as an application for common carrier authority. Publication occurred on December 31, 1983. One protest was filed which was withdrawn upon submission of an amendment by Petitioner restricting the application to transportation for IBM and the matter was processed under the Commission's modified procedure rules. Verified statements were due on July 10, 1984.

Petitioner is seeking authority for "dual operation" as a common and contract carrier. 66 Pa. C.S. §2504 governs Petitioner's request and it states:

"No person or corporation shall at the same time hold a certificate of public convenience as a common carrier by motor vehicle and a permit as a contract carrier by motor vehicle, unless for good cause shown, the commission shall find that such certificate and permit may be held consistently with the public interest."

Petitioner submits that its request is in the public interest as the proposed service exceeds that normally provided by common carriers including ". . . product tracking, warehousing, inventory control, assigning orders, administrative work, daily pick-up and delivery work and daily communications with IBM." In addition, IBM will provide a computer system to Petitioner to assist in the proposed service.

Petitioner intends to use the same equipment and storage facilities in its proposed contract service as is now used in its common carrier service. Further, Petitioner's existing authority permits transportation of commodities similar to that requested in this proceeding e.g. "tabulating and office machines for International Business Machines Corporation" at A-00086551, F. 2. It appears that Petitioner's common carrier business would be substantially similar to its proposed contract service.

A number of cases decided under the provision of the predecessor to 66 Pa. C.S. §2504, formerly designated 66 P.S. §1305, (a virtually identical statute), have held that a carrier may be involved in one line of business as a common carrier and in another as a contract carrier. Railway Express Agency v. Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 195 Pa. Superior Ct. 394, 171 A.2d 860 (1961); Schuylkill Valley Lines v. Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 137 Pa. Superior Ct. 101, 8 A.2d 487 (1939); Hubert et al. v. Pennsylvania Public Service Commission, 118 Pa. Superior Ct. 128, 180 A.23 (1935); Application of Amos R. Kirk, 25 P.U.C. 498 (1946). In each of the foregoing cases however, it was stressed that each of the different lines of business was distinct from the other and facilities and vehicles would not be used in both lines of business at the same time. Schuylkill, supra, cites Hubert and quotes: "'But we refuse to extend or apply this ruling to the use of the same facilities, at the same time, in both common carrier and private carrier transportation.'" 137 Pa. Superior Ct. 101, 107; Hubert, 118 Pa. Superior Ct. 128, 131, 180 A.23. See Railway Express, supra, and Kirk, supra, for similar declarations.

Here, Petitioner seeks to engage in the same line of business as a common and contract carrier utilizing the same vehicles and facilities at the same time; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Petition for Reconsideration be denied.

2. That the application of Dominic Cristinzio, Inc. filed at A-00086551, F. 2, Am-C as modified by the Commission and amended by Petitioner be referred to the Bureau of Non-Rail Transportation for further handling under the Commission's modified procedure.

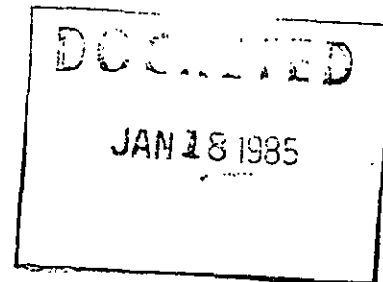

BY THE COMMISSION:

The instant application comes before the Commission on an application filed October 17, 1983. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of December 31, 1983. A protest filed by Centre Carriers Corp., was withdrawn when the application

was amended so that all service be provided "for" International Business Machines Corporation.

The now unopposed application is certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing. The record consists of verified statements submitted by the applicant and its supporting shipper.

After due consideration of the record, we find:

1. The applicant is a currently certificated common carrier with specific authority to provide service for International Business Machines Corporation in Philadelphia and from points in Philadelphia to points within 25 miles and vice versa.

2. The applicant now seeks to expand service for International Business Machines Corporation to allow transportation between points in 27 eastern Pennsylvania counties.

3. The applicant will continue to operate from its facilities at Philadelphia using 21 motor vehicles.

4. The applicant provides specialized services such as product tracking, warehousing, inventory control, assigning orders and administrative work. It has daily contact with its supporting shipper.

5. The applicant's financial capacity to render the expanded service is reflect by its annual reports on file with the Commission.

6. International Business Machines Corporation supports the applicant for expanded service indicating the applicant will be requested to transport an average of 10 shipments per week intrastate within the scope of the application territory.

7. The applicant now provides limited pick-up and delivery service within the scope of its authority. International Business Machines Corporation plans to aid the applicant in meeting increased demand for its service by providing a computer to expedite daily pick-up and delivery and provide other services.

8. The applicant has the experience, equipment and fitness to provide the proposed service as amended.

9. Approval of the application, as amended, is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application, as amended, be and is hereby approved and that the certificate issued April 30, 1965, as amended, be further amended to include the following right:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, business and office machines, electronic manufacturing systems, parts and supplies thereof, that are manufactured,


sold, leased, distributed or dealt in by International Business Machines Corporation, for International Business Machines Corporation between points in the counties of Adams, Berks, Bucks, Cabon, Centre, Chester, Cumberland, Dauphin, Delaware, Franklin, Fulton, Huntingdon, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lehigh, Mifflin, Montgomery, Montour, Northampton, Northumberland, Perry, Philadelphia, Schuylkill, Snyder, Union and York.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein, to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the carrier, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it shall have complied with the requirements of the Public Utility Code and the rules and regulations of the Commission relating to the filing and acceptance of a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of the order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

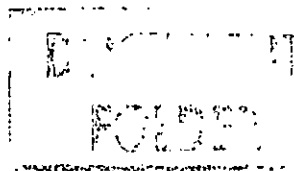
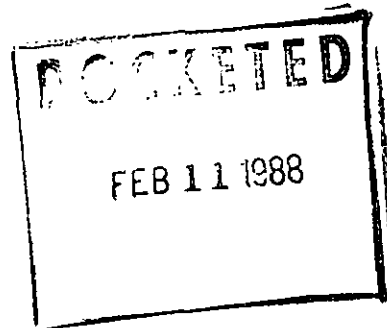

O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application (corrected) filed May 26, 1987. Public notice of the application was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of June 13, 1987. Protests to the application were filed by 12 certificated carriers, however, all of the protests were withdrawn when the applicant restrictively amended the application by excluding the transportation of office furniture, used or in use.

The application is now unprotested and the record is certified to the Commission for its decision without an oral hearing. The record consists of verified statements submitted by the applicant and three supporting shippers.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

Domenic Cristinzio, Inc. (applicant), is a Pennsylvania corporation currently certificated to provide common carrier service. The applicant had sought by the instant application the right to transport business and office machines and electronic or mechanical equipment, including, but not limited to, copiers, computers, x-ray machines, and inserting machines, and office furniture, new, used and in use, between points in the counties of Luzerne, Lackawanna, Monroe, Carbon, Northampton, Lehigh, Berks, Schuylkill, Columbia and Montour, and from points in said counties, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa. In responding to 12 protests, the applicant restrictively amended the application to exclude the transportation of office furniture, used and in use.

The applicant corporation is located at 1700 Tomlinson Road, Philadelphia. As a currently certificated carrier, the applicant is engaged in the transportation of tabulating and office machines and other items of property for IBM within the area of application. The applicant also holds authority to transport the same commodities involved herein from the warehouse of Domenic Cristinzio, Inc. located in the city and county of Philadelphia. Also, the applicant is currently authorized to transport the commodities involved herein between points in the counties of Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery, Philadelphia, and from said counties to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

The equipment of the applicant currently consists of two tractors and 22 trailers. Of this equipment, one tractor and 17 trailers are currently being leased. The applicant also has available the accessorial equipment necessary to move the commodities involved herein.

At the present time, the applicant is providing transportation for the supporting shippers and others pursuant to its current operating authority. The instant application is the result of the applicant receiving a request from his clients to provide service to a broader

area of the Commonwealth. As an experienced carrier, the applicant foresees no difficulty in meeting the needs of the shipping public with regards to the various commodities for which it seeks authority to transport.

A. Albero, traffic manager for Unisys Corporation, states that Unisys is a computer manufacturing firm located in Blue Bell, Montgomery County. It is the intention of Unisys to tender the applicant approximately five to ten shipments per week varying in weight from approximately 200 to 10,000 pounds. Shipments will originate in Philadelphia and Montgomery Counties and will move to and between the counties of Luzerne, Lackawanna, Monroe, Montour, Carbon, Northampton, Lehigh, Berks, Schuylkill and Columbia.

As a result of the specialized nature of the product to be tendered the applicant, Unisys requires better control over the transportation of its products. Shipments will consist of computer equipment for pickup and delivery to customers and other Unisys facilities. The transportation to be provided by the applicant requires specialized service and specialized handling.

Edward J. Thompson, branch manager, for Shaw/Walker, Philadelphia, set forth that the applicant will be tendered new office furniture for transportation from Philadelphia to points in the city and county of Philadelphia, and to points in the counties of Bucks, Montgomery, Chester, Delaware, Luzerne, Lackawanna, Monroe, Carbon, Northampton, Lehigh, Berks, Schuylkill, Columbia and Montour. The applicant is currently providing service for Shaw/Walker under its current authority however, due to expanded business, Shaw/Walker requires service to a broader territorial area.

Sean A. Riley, operations manager for Concepts Furniture, Inc., Philadelphia, states that the shipper is a contract office furniture distributor, marketing in the tri-state area of Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware. Due to an increase in business, the shipper requires the applicant to transport furniture to points in the counties of Luzerne, Monroe, Lehigh, Berks and Schuylkill. Service is required to, between and from the named counties. Service has been rendered by the applicant under its current authority and the shipper desires the services of the applicant within the expanded territory sought by the instant application.

The applicant in the instant proceeding is a certificated carrier experienced in handling the commodities involved herein. It has both the equipment and the knowledge necessary to meet the needs of the various supporting shippers which may ship the commodities sought by the instant application. The supporting shippers have indicated a need for the proposed service in the area of application and are desirous of the applicant's proposed service.

We find:

1. That the applicant is fit, willing and able to render the proposed transportation, as amended.

2. That the applicant has met its statutory burden of demonstrating that a public need exists.

3. That approval of the application, as amended, is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application, as amended, be and is hereby approved, and that the certificate issued to the applicant on April 30, 1965, as amended, be further amended to include the following right:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, business and office machines and electronic or mechanical equipment, including, but not limited to, copiers, computers, x-ray machines, and inserting machines, and new office furniture, between points in the counties of Luzerne, Lackawanna, Monroe, Carbon, Northampton, Lehigh, Berks, Schuylkill, Columbia and Montour, and from points in said counties, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation granted herein until it shall have complied with the requirements of the Public Utility Code and the rules and regulations of this Commission relative to the filing and acceptance of a tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of service of this order complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein, to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the carrier, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.

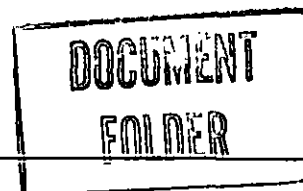
