Dear Respondent:

On January 2, 2003, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety instituted a Complaint against Predator Trucking Company, respondent, alleging failure to file an application with this Commission prior to abandoning or discontinuing service, violating 52 Pa. Code §3.381(a)(1)(v) and 66 Pa. C.S. §1102(a)(2) and, by failure to maintain adequate, efficient and safe service and facilities, violating 66 Pa. C.S. §1501.

Respondent was duly notified that, if an answer was filed which admitted or failed to deny the allegations in the complaint, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety would request the Commission to enter an order imposing a penalty.

By answer filed with this Commission on January 6, 2003, respondent did not object to the cancellation of its certificate of public convenience.

Therefore, the allegations in the Complaint are deemed to be admitted. The Complaint is hereby sustained and the **Certificate of Public Convenience**, issued to respondent at A-00109468, is **hereby canceled**.



Additionally, Respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1.1 et seq. and the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1 et seq. In view of the **cancellation of respondent's Certificate of Public Convenience**, it is specifically prohibited from rendering service as a common carrier by motor vehicle in intrastate commerce in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
