(a) Application of Carlisle Carrier Corp., Carlisle, Cumberland County, a corporation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for temporary authority to transport as a common carrier, property (except commodities in bulk and household goods in use) for Reckitt & Colman, Inc., from the facilities owned, leased or utilized by Reckitt & Colman, Inc., located in the township of Lower Swatara, Dauphin County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

(b) Applicant has filed an application for permanent authority, larger in scope than the temporary authority, which has been protested by a single carrier. Applicant currently operates pursuant to a grant of emergency temporary authority - larger in scope than the temporary authority - adopted at Public Meeting of February 25, 1993. The issuance of the emergency temporary authority was based on an immediate need for transportation as the supporting shipper had been utilizing applicant's service from the facilities of Exel Logistics, Inc. in Cumberland County and shipper has decided to relocate to another warehouse located in Dauphin County. As the temporary authority application is for service from the facilities located in the township of Lower Swatara, Dauphin County, the authority to issue will be so worded. A review of the record indicates a continuing need for the service exists and that a grant of temporary authority is in the public interest.

(c) The Bureau of Transportation recommends that the Commission adopt the proposed order approving the application for temporary authority pending disposition of the permanent authority application.

O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application for temporary authority filed February 17, 1993. A permanent authority application, larger in scope, has also been filed and has been met by a single protest. The temporary authority proposed herein is unprotested.

The applicant was granted emergency temporary authority by Commission order adopted February 25, 1993 to provide service for the supporting shipper herein. The issuance of the emergency temporary authority was based on an immediate need for transportation as the supporting shipper had been utilizing applicant's service from the facilities of Exel Logistics, Inc. in Cumberland County and shipper has decided to relocate to another warehouse located in Dauphin County. Of the two carriers providing service for the shipper from the facilities of Exel in Cumberland County, Gabler does not have authority from the new location and New England Motor Freight cannot supply

sufficient equipment. We see a continuing need for the service. As the temporary authority application is for service from the facilities located in the township of Lower Swatara, Dauphin County, the authority to issue will be so worded.

The tariff currently on file for the emergency temporary authority will be effective for the temporary authority issued herein.

A review of the evidence indicates that there is continuing need for service and a grant of temporary authority is in the public interest; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application for temporary authority be and is hereby approved, granting the following right, pending disposition of the permanent authority application:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, property for Reckitt & Colman, Inc., from the facilities owned, leased or utilized by Reckitt & Colman, Inc., located in the township of Lower Swatara, Dauphin County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa;


subject to the following conditions:

- (1) That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport commodities in bulk.
- (2) That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport household goods in use.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That approval of the temporary authority application shall have no bearing on the application for permanent authority.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the tariff on file with the Commission for the emergency temporary authority is acceptable for the temporary authority issued herein.
