SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER MODIFYING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE

BY THE COMMISSION:

It appearing that part of the rights granted to Carlisle Carrier Corp., under the certificate of public convenience issued at A-00109478 have been transferred to Pennsylvania Delivery Systems, Inc., at A-00110288, and are now contained under the certificate of public convenience issued to it, and that Carlisle Carrier Corp., is retaining certain authority; and the matters and things involved having been duly considered by the Commission; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That upon compliance with the order at A-00110288, the right granted in the order adopted May 23, 1991, entered May 30, 1991, at A-00109478, F. 1, Am-A which reads as follows:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, property for Purina Mills, Inc., from its facilities in the township of Hampden, Cumberland County; from the facilities of its subsidiary Bay Mor Pet Feeds, Inc., in the borough of Cressona, Schuylkill County; and from the facilities of Ralston Purina Company in the township of Hampden, Cumberland County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa;

subject to the following condition:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport petroleum and petroleum products in bulk, in tank vehicles;

BE and IS HEREBY CANCELLED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That upon compliance with the conditions and requirements as set forth in the order at A-00110288, the right contained in the order adopted April 2, 1992, entered April 9, 1992 at A-00109478, F. 1, Am-B, be and is hereby modified so that it shall now read as follows:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, property between the facilities owned, leased or utilized by Excel Logistics, Inc., and from said facilities to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa;

subject to the following conditions:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport petroleum and petroleum products in bulk in tank or hopper-type vehicles, or dry litharge in bulk;

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport property of Purina Mills, Inc., from its facilities in the township of Hampden, Cumberland County; from the facilities of its subsidiary, Bay Mor Pet Feeds, Inc., in the borough of Cressona, Schuylkill County; and from the facilities of Ralston Purina Company, in the township of Hampden, Cumberland County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the operating rights authorized for transfer, and all rules, regulations and rates applicable thereto as contained in the transferor's tariff are hereby cancelled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the transferor amend its tariff according to this supplemental order.
