In Response to the November 17, 2015 ORDER:

On September 21, 2015, a hearing date and time was set for December 1, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. (see attach. #1) for a dispute between Mindy & Binnie Zied with P.E.C.O., which was the product of a "forced Formal Complaint", because P.E.C.O. refused to fix that which they did beginning in March, 2014, to include but is not limited to the threat that if a formal complaint was not filed, the electric to the Zied's residence would be cut off.

On September 30, 2015 in a Pre-Hearing Order, ¶13 led us to believe that the documents previously filed with this tribunal had not been received, when this was presented:

"The Complainants Mindy Jaye Zied and Binnie A. Zied have provided attachments to the formal complaint. The Complainants are cautioned that exhibits for the Initial Hearing must be produced at the hearing. The attachments to the formal complaint at [sic] not in the record and must be produced at the hearing."

The aforementioned paragraph caused the Zied(s) to have to produce further paperwork, even though another document came out in an attempt to correct ¶13.

As the disability in the paperwork by Mindy Zied's Psychiatrist described, it should be clear that Ms. Zied has the propensity to have "trust issues". The ongoing procedures have not proved to gain Ms. Zied's trust pertaining to this matter, which might raise the issue of recusal. Let us

remember that the expression "fair hearing", includes the word "fair", and should never include being forced to be physically present at a hearing, when an individual's disability precludes their presence.

In the Zied's 10/9/15 submission, is Exhibit #10 which clearly described Mindy Zied's disability. Exhibit #11, in the same document shows that Ms. Zied's disability is worth accommodating by an SSA ALJ opinion rendered on November 28, 2014.


Attached to this letter is Binnie Zied's physician's letter pertaining to her "health" as a 96 (now 97) year old woman, and on August 21, 2015, a letter from Binnie Zied's physician was faxed to PECO's Attorney, William Donohue, see here attach. #3, which was also included in the Formal Complaint, at Exhibit FF.

A Disability Accommodation request has been asked for time and time again, or to refer this to the "COMMISSION" for an Interlocutory Opinion/Review of the accommodation request. That has not been done.

However, based upon the same disability, which derives from a brain injury, (which includes memory issues), we have attached a letter dated November 20, 2015 from Ms. Zied's Neurologist's Office.

As stated in this letter, on August 27, 2015, almost a month prior to the scheduled hearing by this tribunal setting a hearing date of December 1, 2015, Mindy Zied's physician prior to that time had already scheduled her for an Appointment in their office, for December 1, 2015, which aside from that which has already been said, argued, and maintains, precludes her from physically being in two places at the same time. Since it took (3) months in being able to obtain this appointment, Ms. Zied will be seeing her Neurologist the morning of December 1, 2015.


To Whom It May Concern:

I am the physician of Binnie Zied. It has recently been brought to my attention that PECO has sent a 10 day shut off notice to be processed on August 31, 2015.

My patient, Binnie Zied is 96 years old, and she resides in the upper level of the residence listed above. It is my professional opinion that due to temperatures rising from 95 - 100 degrees this summer, that if Ms. Binnie Zied's electric is shut off, it will pose imminent danger to her health.

It would be more advantageous if there are alternative measures in resolving the issues which might be pending before PECO, than to shut off the electric at this particular residence.
