Notice of the above-captioned application appears in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of Saturday, October 6, 1990, at pages 5098 and 5099. There are some errors which certainly can be expected with such a large publication. While all of the errors are technical from the standpoint of members of the public reviewing the notice, some are substantive with regard to the rights to be obtained by Evergreen Express Lines, Inc.

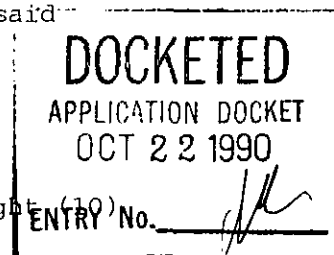
Concerning the substantive errors, we respectfully request that the following corrections be made in any order issued in this case (the numbers in parenthesis match the number of the right in the publication):

(3) - Should read as follows:

To interchange property, authorized at rights (1) and (2) above, with Class A, Class B and Class D carriers at any point within the area or on the route authorized by said rights in pickup and delivery service between points authorized by said rights.

(9) - "plant" should read "plants"

(10) - "plant" which is set forth at two places in right should read "plants" each time.

(11) - There should a comma after the word "publications" in the second line so that the first two lines will read as follows:

"newspapers, magazines, books, catalogs, pamphlets, periodicals, publications, and parts" etc.

This is important to comply with the rule of last antecedent for interpretation of what the "parts thereof" refer to.

(13) - "materials, supplies" should read "materials and supplies"

(19) - "from a point of the village of Raubenstine" should read "from a point near the village of Raubenstine" and "Hellertown" should read "Killerton."

We submit that no republication is necessary in view of the nature of the corrections.


Dear Mr. Nurick:
