**ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE
OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE/PERMIT**

BY THE COMMISSION:


At its Public Meeting held August 26, 1993, the Commission adopted an order directing the above-named respondent to show cause why its certificate of public convenience or permit should not be cancelled. This action was prompted by respondent's failure to file its 1992 Annual Report with this Commission on or before March 31, 1993 as required by Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §504 and C.S. §2508 and 52 Pa. Code §29.42, §31.9 and §33.103.

Our Order directed that an answer or other responsive pleading be filed within twenty (20) days and that, in the absence of any filing, the averments in the order would be admitted.

The order was served on Respondent on September 17, 1993 and to date, more than twenty (20) days later, respondent has failed to file an acceptable answer or to unilaterally terminate the order by submitting the Annual Report as provided for in the Commission's order; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That unless the certificate of public convenience or contract carrier permit held by respondent at Application Docket No. A-00109492 has been cancelled by a prior order of this Commission and has not been reinstated, that certificate or permit is hereby cancelled, and all rights, powers and privileges granted thereby are terminated.
