MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO") and Eagle Road Enterprises, L.P. ("Complainant"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby request a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter as follows:

1. A telephonic hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Monday, December 14, 2015 at 10:00 a.m.
2. The Complainant alleges in their formal complaint that an aerial wire feeding power to their building was too low. The Complainant alleges that a truck hit the wire causing voltage to drop and damage their compressor and air conditioning unit.
3. At the hearing, PECO will present the testimony of DSO Manager, Charles Crumbley to testify to the aerial wire heights raised by the Complainant.
4. Mr. Crumbley is unavailable Monday, December 14, 2015, due to a prescheduled vacation.
5. In addition, PECO's counsel and Eagle Road Enterprises' counsel have been in resolution discussions.
6. The parties believe that with additional time, this matter may be resolved.

7. As a PECO witnesses is unavailable for the hearing and the parties wish to continue resolution discussions, PECO and the Complainant jointly request a continuance of this matter.

8. PECO and the Complainant therefore respectfully request that the hearing be continued to a further date.
