A-00088807, F. 2, Am-K, which indicates: (1) the supporting witnesses must give evidence which is probative and relevant to the application proceeding; (2) the supporting witnesses must identify Pennsylvania origin and destination points between which they require transportation and those points must correspond with the scope of the operating territory specified in the application including requests for vice versa authority; and (3) the number of witnesses which will represent a cross section of the public on the issue of need will vary with the breadth of the intended territory and commodity description.

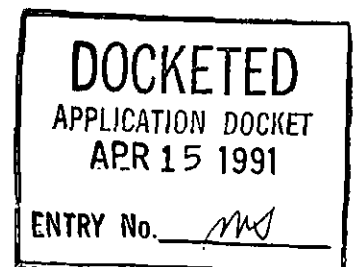
You are being granted an initial thirty (30) days to file verified statements. They will be due on or before May 13, 1991.

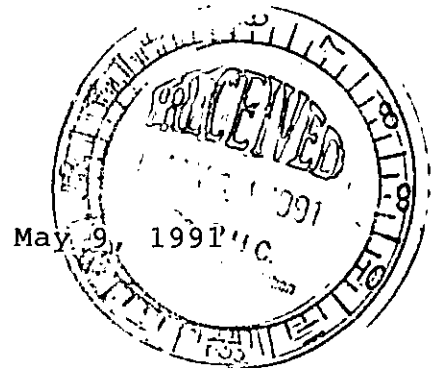

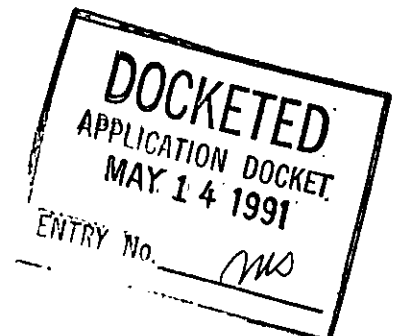


1. Applicants name is Sally J. Fiesler and she resides at 10521 Greenlee Road, Waterford, PA 16441.

3. The applicant is not affiliated with other carriers.

The vehicles are checked every day by applicant and drivers for any sign of performance defects and to maintain optimum operating standards.



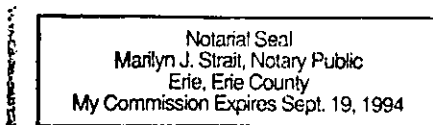

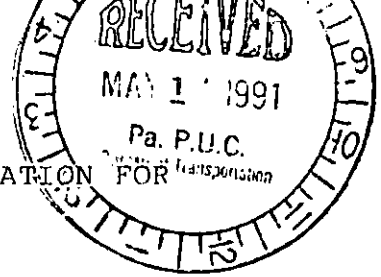

Nelson's Alternative Disposal Systems is located in Summit Township of Erie County in Pennsylvania.

I, Helen Nelson, am a partner/owner of Nelson's Alternative Disposal Systems. I am qualified to make decisions for the overall operations of the company.

The general description of Nelson's Alternative Disposal Systems is a DER approved waste wood grinding facility. We will be having materials trucked in such as stumps, branches, leaves, brush, pallets, crating, lumber, and trees which will be processed through our grinding machine. The end product is a high grade mulch product which will be stockpiled to age and resold for landscaping needs.

As of the present date, we do not know the volume this facility will be taking in or producing. The intended use for trucking will be greatly needed once our facility opens which is tentatively June 1991.

Specific origins and destinations will be mainly in Erie County. From Downtown Erie, Millcreek, Fairview, Girard, East and West Springfield, Lake City Townships to Harborcreek, North East, Wesleyville, Lawrence Park, Waterford, and McKean Townships.

The type of service required for Nelson's Alternative Disposal Systems will be trucking of waste wood into our facility and also delivery of the mulch to homeowners.

There are no similar application supported.

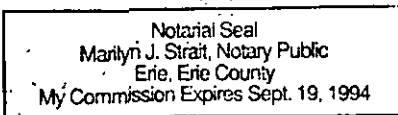

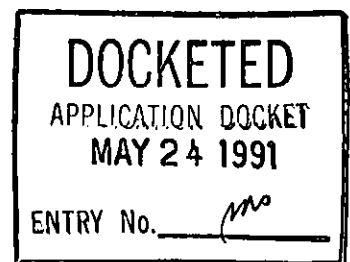
This will acknowledge receipt of the verified statements delivered to our office on May 14, 1991. Specifically, a statement on your own behalf as the applicant was received, together with statements from P. B. Excavating Company and Nelson's Alternating Disposal Systems.

We pointed out in our initial request for verified statements that the supporting witnesses must provide evidence which is relevant to the proceeding, and that they must identify Pennsylvania points of origin between which service is required. You are seeking authority to transport gravel, sand, stone and top soil, in bulk, in dump vehicles, between points in Erie County. The verified statements fall short of supporting a grant of the authority you have proposed.

We have no problem with regards to your statement as the applicant, except that you state you have been in business for six years and that you provide general hauling service. Not having operating authority from this Commission, we ask that you advise under what conditions you have provided service.

The statement of P. B. Excavating Company does not indicate the specific points of origin and destination in Erie County. It merely states that service is required within the boundaries of Erie County. It must specify the commodities involved in its transportation needs, together with specific origins and destinations in Erie County.

Nelson's Alternative Disposal System states that it has stumps, branches, leaves, brush, pallets, crating, lumber, and trees hauled into its waste wood grinding facility. We cannot accept this statement as probative evidence since the company's needs have nothing to do with transportation of gravel, sand, stone and top soil.



May 23, 1991

You have applied for authority between all points in Erie County. The evidence of one shipper who fails to show where service is needed, simply does not justify a grant of the authority you seek. We suggest that you obtain support from a good representative cross section of shippers of gravel, stone, sand and top soil in Erie County, and the points of origin and destination should be representative of the need for service between all points in Erie County.

We are allowing an additional thirty days from the date of this letter to accumulate the necessary support. Should you have any questions or require additional time, please do not hesitate to contact the undersigned. (717-787-4387).
