

IT IS ORDERED:

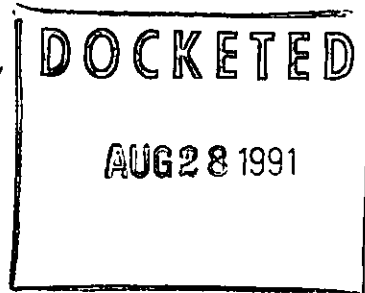
1. That the Protest of Gary R. Louderback, t/d/b/a Louderback Transportation Company, be dismissed for lack of prosecution.
