Dear Mr. Ungarischer:

Please find under cover of this letter the Bond Rider No. 3372771 recently filed by your company with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission as part of a supplier's license requirements under Section 2809(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code.

While the Commission requires a supplier to file an **original** bond, letter of credit, continuation certificate, amendment, or other financial instrument, it also requires that the name of the principal on the financial instrument **match exactly** with the name of the company licensed by the Commission.

The Rider you filed does not reflect the correct name of your company. It should read "M&L Service Providers, LLC" without the "DBA Diamond Energy." First, I am enclosing a newly issued PUC license to correct a typo appearing on your current license by removing the "s" from the word "Services." Second, although your Rider is an original, please revise and send me an original with the "DBA Diamond Energy" removed from the security. Third, if you wish to change the name of your company to M&L Service Providers LLC d/b/a Diamond Energy, you must first apply to the Pennsylvania Department of State for such a change, and then file that change with the Commission for review and approval.

Therefore, please file the original, corrected Bond Rider with my office within 20 days of the date of this letter, preferably by overnight delivery, remembering that the financial instrument and the name on your license must match exactly.
