BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 9, 1993, Joyco, Inc., t/d/b/a Rapid Delivery (Joyco) filed an application for emergency temporary authority (ETA), for the transfer of all of the operating rights of Chariots of Fire Messenger & Delivery Service, Inc., under the certificate issued at A-00107486 subject to the same limitations and conditions. Joyco also filed corresponding applications for temporary authority and permanent authority. See 52 Pa. Code §§3.383-3.385 (regulations for ETA and TA applications).

By a Tentative Decision entered March 18, 1993, the Commission denied Joyco's application for ETA. From our decision, Joyco filed exceptions which are the subject of his Order. After Joyco's exceptions were filed, the Commission approved Joyco's application for permanent authority. Since Joyco's application for permanent authority has been granted, Joyco's application for ETA and the exceptions filed in regard thereto have become moot; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

That the exceptions of Joyco, Inc., t/d/b/a Rapid Delivery to the Commission's Tentative Decision at Docket No. A-00109534, F.6000, are hereby dismissed as moot.
