**OBJECTIONS OF PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION  
TO THE COMPLAINANT'S DISCOVERY REQUESTS**

AND NOW comes the Respondent, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric"), by and through its counsel, Gross McGinley, LLP, and hereby files the following Objections to Complainant's Request for Discovery:

1. On or about December 7, 2015, Complainant, Diane Marie Seese (hereinafter "Complainant" and/or "Seese") mailed for filing with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, and served upon Respondent, a document entitled "RE: Service and Reliability Rules of Discovery." (A true and correct copy of the document is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein). Respondent PPL Electric received a copy of the same on December 11, 2015.

2. Requests for Discovery, inclusive of written Interrogatories to a party, are governed by 52 Pa. Code § 5.341.

3. The timing and sequence of Discovery is governed by 52 Pa. Code § 5.331.

4. When Discovery is necessary, "a party shall initiate discovery as early in the proceedings as reasonably possible. In a proceeding, the right to discovery commences when a

complaint, protest or other adverse pleading is filed or when the commission institutes an investigation or on the record proceeding, whichever is earlier.” 52 Pa. Code §5.331.

5. The instant matter was commenced by the filing of a Complaint on August 27, 2015. An initial hearing was noticed on October 22, 2015 for November 9, 2015. Thereafter, the hearing was rescheduled to December 21, 2015.

6. When written Interrogatories are served, the Interrogatories must “relate to matters which can be inquired into under §§ 5.321, 5.323 and 5.324 (relating to scope; hearing preparation material; and discovery of expert testimony) and may include requests that the answering party provide copies of documents without making a separate request for the production of documents under § 5.349 (relating to requests for documents, entry for inspection and other purposes).” 52 Pa. Code §5.341(c).

7. When Interrogatories are propounded on a party, “each interrogatory should be limited to a single question or request for information.” 52 Pa. Code §5.341(d).

8. When Interrogatories are propounded on a party, the propounding party “should use a logical and sequential numbering system for Interrogatories.” 52 Pa. Code §5.341(e).

9. In addition, the entity responding to the Interrogatories shall have twenty (20) days to file an Answer. 52 Pa. Code §5.342(d).

10. Respondent, PPL Electric, objects to the Interrogatories on the basis of timeliness. Complainant failed to serve her Interrogatories in sufficient time as to permit responses without delaying the hearing which is scheduled for December 21, 2015. The instant matter has been pending since August 27, 2015, and the hearing was duly noticed.

11. Respondent, PPL Electric, objects to Complainant’s Interrogatories insomuch as they do not comply with the requirements of 52 Pa Code § 5.341, in that the Interrogatories do


not relate to discoverable information, are not limited to single questions or requests for information, and are not in a logical numbering system. The manner in which the Interrogatories are propounded do not permit respondent, PPL Electric, to make meaningful replies and objections to each individual Interrogatory.

12. Respondent, PPL Electric, objects as Complainant's requests are not reasonably related to Complainant's allegations of service safety and reliability.


