

PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Norfolk Southern Railway Company (“Norfolk Southern”), by and through its counsel, Nauman, Smith, Shissler & Hall, LLP, hereby files this petition for extension of time to perform the work ordered in the Commission’s Secretarial Letter dated July 3, 2014, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, based upon the following:

1. The aforementioned Secretarial Letter ordered Norfolk Southern to install new automatically operated flashing-light railroad crossing warning signals with short arm gates and an additional inverted cantilever in the northeast quadrant at the subject crossing, generally in accordance with the approved plans and in accordance with Part 8 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. Pursuant to numbered Paragraph 14 of the Secretarial Letter, the work was ordered to be completed on or before December 31, 2015.


2. Norfolk Southern requests an extension of time until June 30, 2016, to perform the work.

3. Norfolk Southern is unable to complete the required work by the December 31, 2015, deadline because plan approval and construction authorization from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation has just recently been received by Norfolk Southern, and plan approval from the Commission was just received on November 19, 2015. Norfolk Southern needs time to order and obtain materials and for its construction department to schedule and complete the project.

WHEREFORE, Norfolk Southern Railway Company respectfully requests an extension of time until June 30, 2016, to complete the crossing alteration project ordered in numbered Paragraph 4 of the Commission's Secretarial Letter dated July 3, 2014.




