Dear Mr. Schwab:

I have received and reviewed the verified statements filed in the above-referenced application proceeding. There is sufficient support for limousine service between points in Carbon County and from said county to points in Pennsylvania. The support for Schuylkill County is minimal with Joseph Blazosky, Funeral Home supporting service from Hometown, Schuylkill County, to local cemeteries. Perhaps specific points of destination could be given. One or two other statements showing points of origin in Schuylkill County would be good.

I am also having trouble with Lynette Tirpak's statement as a travel agent. The Commission cannot give weight to unlicensed passenger brokers providing brokering service between points in Pennsylvania. I'm almost sure the statement of Lynette Tirpak cannot be accepted under any circumstances, regardless of what we may have discussed as per our telephone conversation of November 7, 1996. You can still question her as to her service, but if she is securing limousine service for passengers as herein this application, she would require a P.U.C. broker's license. I am enclosing a questionnaire form that our Enforcement Section uses in determining the distinction between a broker and an agent. Tirpak's support covered service to the ABE Airport. Support is needed as per the restrictive amendment for the transportation of persons from the Allentown/Bethlehem/Easton Airport limited to the return transportation of passengers previously transported by applicant to the airport.



The other verified statement in support we discussed was that of Megan Anderson of Porvaznik's Florists, wherein I interpreted that the florist required the transportation of packages. You indicated that the service she was supporting was for flowers and limousine as a service offered to wedding couples. Please have the statement revised to reflect what actually is intended.

I am hereby granting you an additional thirty (30) days to submit additional information and/or statements. Verified statements are now due on or before December 13, 1996.

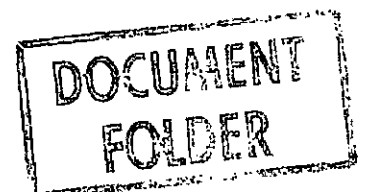
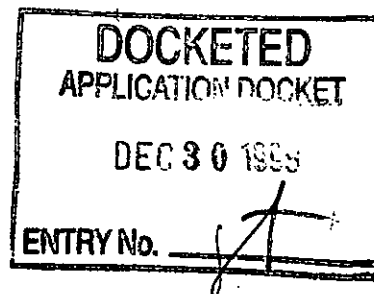

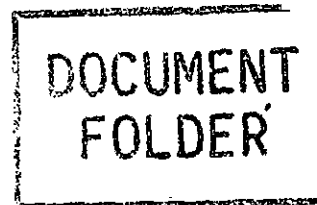
