To Whom It May Concern:

Your application for the right to provide common carrier service, transporting persons in group and party service, using vehicles having a seating capacity of 16 – 28 passengers, including the driver, has been reviewed.

It has been determined that the following requirements must be met before service may be provided within Pennsylvania. **You may not operate until these requirements are satisfied.**

YOU ARE ADVISED: THAT YOU MUST FILE A FORM E, AS EVIDENCE OF BODILY INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE LIABILITY INSURANCE. You must contact your insurance agent/broker so that the required evidence of permanent insurance will be filed with this Commission.

FAILURE TO FILE THE ABOVE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER CAN RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.

You may want to operate prior to filing permanent proof of insurance. Temporary proof of insurance consists of one of the following:

- a. A copy of the declaration page of the insurance policy; **or**
- b. A copy of a valid binder of insurance.

Temporary proof of insurance is good for 60 days from the date of this letter. You may begin operating only after your notification that the temporary proof of insurance has been accepted.

Upon the filing of an acceptable Form E, a certificate of public convenience will be issued authorizing the following right:

To transport, as a motor common carrier, persons in group and party service, operating vehicles seating 16 – 28 passengers, including the driver, between points in Pennsylvania, excluding service that is under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority.

Subject to the following condition:


That the service here authorized is limited to the operation of vehicles seating 16 – 28 passengers, including the driver.

If you have not previously submitted a copy of a current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review which will be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date your certificate of public convenience is issued/entered.

Failure to submit to the Safety Fitness Review will result in cancellation of your application, and require the filing of a new application and filing fee.

The applicant is hereby advised of its obligation to familiarize itself with the requirements of 52 Pa. Code as applicable to the operation of a common carrier as authorized by this Order. Applicant is further advised that failure to comply with all applicable requirements may subject the carrier to penalties, including fines, suspension of operating rights or cancellation of its authority.
