Secretary Chiavetta:

The purpose of this letter is to respond to Mr. Moyer's ("Complainant") letter dated December 14, 2015, which was filed in the above-captioned proceeding. The December 14, 2015 letter requests that the Office of Special Assistants consider the letter and the attached bill as additional "material evidence" in its review of the Complainant's Exceptions to Administrative Law Judge Cynthia Williams Fordham's (the "ALJ") Initial Decision.

The December 14, 2015 letter and the attached bill should not be considered by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") in its evaluation of the Complainant's Exceptions. The Complainant is attempting to supplement the record with additional evidence several months after the record was closed on June 30, 2015. Effectively, the Complainant's request would deny PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric" or the "Company") due process by introducing additional arguments and evidence at a point when the Company would have no opportunity to respond.

In addition, the contents of the letter offer nothing new to this case. Indeed, they demonstrate the Complainant's continued failure to understand the one-month lag of applying credits under PPL Electric's virtual meter aggregation program, which is thoroughly explained on pages 34 to 37 of PPL Electric's Reply Brief. Therefore, no need exists to supplement the record with the Complainant's largely duplicative arguments and evidence.

Further, the Complainant fails to recognize that the Commission's decision in the above-captioned proceeding will fully and finally resolve the issues he has raised concerning the Company's virtual meter aggregation program and billing process. As a result, the Commission's decision could affect not only the past bills and credits received by the Complainant, but the bills and credits he receives going forward.

For these reasons, PPL Electric respectfully submits that the Commission should not consider the Complainant's December 14, 2015 letter and the bill attached to that letter as additional post-hearing, extra-record evidence in its evaluation of the Complainant's Exceptions to the Initial Decision.


