O R D E R

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on applications for permanent and temporary authority filed July 11, 1994. Public notice of the applications was given in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of August 6, 1994. The unopposed applications are certified to the Commission for its decision without oral hearing. The record consists of verified statements entered by Thomas Fleming, president of Aim Leasing Drivers Company, t/d/b/a Aim Dedicated and George R. Bauer, corporate traffic manager for Dietrich Industries, Inc.

DISCUSSION AND FINDINGS

The applicant is seeking both permanent authority and temporary authority to provide the subject service for Dietrich Industries, Inc. Our consideration of the permanent authority application herein will require that no further positive action be taken on the temporary authority application and that application will be dismissed by the instant order.

The applicant's principal office is in Girard, Ohio, but it maintains a maintenance facility in Pittsburgh, Allegheny County. It will station equipment at the shipper's place of business in West Wheatfield Township, Indiana County. The applicant intends to dedicate equipment to the use of the shipper. It will supply tractors with which to pull the trailers owned by the shipper. The applicant is prepared to commence operations for the shipper immediately. As a currently certificated carrier, there is a presumption of fitness.

Dietrich Industries, Inc., requires the transportation of steel building products, and materials, equipment and supplies used in the manufacture and distribution of steel building products, these commodities include galvanized steel coil and sheets, salvage-grade coils, which must be transported in dump or flat trailers and related equipment and supplies. Outbound shipments will consist of the steel building products with all other commodities transported inbound. The origin point for service is the facilities of Dietrich Industries in West Wheatfield Township, Indiana County. Destination points include all points in Pennsylvania such as Pittsburgh, Erie, Harrisburg, Philadelphia, Allentown, State College and Latrobe. Inbound origin points include Pittsburgh, Philadelphia, Bethlehem, Dravosburg, Ambridge, Sharon and others. The shipper has a daily need for service both inbound and outbound. It anticipates one or more truckload shipments per day will be tendered to the applicant.

We find:

1. The applicant stands ready, willing and able to render the proposed service.

2. The applicant has the experience, equipment and fitness to render the proposed service.

3. The applicant has the unqualified support of the shipper named in the application and that support is representative of the proposed service.

4. Approval of the unopposed application is proper for the accommodation and convenience of the public; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the unopposed application be and is hereby approved and that the certificate issued August 10, 1993, be amended to include the following right:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, steel building products, and materials, equipment and supplies used in the manufacture and distribution of steel building products, for Dietrich Industries, Inc., from its facilities in the township of West Wheatfield, Indiana County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein to the extent that it duplicates authority now held by or subsequently granted to the applicant, shall not be construed as conferring more than one operating right.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall not engage in any transportation in this application until the following is submitted to the Commission:

1. A tariff establishing just and reasonable rates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the temporary authority application filed in this proceeding be and is hereby dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That in the event said applicant has not, on or before sixty (60) days from the date of the service of this order, complied with the requirements hereinbefore set forth, the application shall be dismissed without further proceedings.
