BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter comes before the Commission on an application for emergency temporary authority (ETA) filed July 7, 1994. Corresponding applications for temporary and permanent authority have also been filed. The record consists of verified statements filed by the applicant and the supporting shipper.

Aim Leasing Drivers Company, t/d/b/a Aim Dedicated (Aim or applicant), is a corporation of the State of Ohio, with its principal place of business in Girard, Ohio. It currently holds authority from this Commission and maintains adequate insurance coverage. As pertinent to the proposed operation, Aim will utilize a terminal in Pittsburgh and will dedicate ten vehicles to the service of the shipper.

George R. Bauer, corporate traffic manager for Dietrich Industries, Inc. (Dietrich or shipper), submitted a verified statement in support of this ETA application. Dietrich operates a facility in West Wheatfield Township, Indiana County, and requires the inbound transportation of raw materials and the outbound transportation of finished products on a daily basis. Service was provided by Lend Lease Dedicated Services until June 30, 1994, when it terminated its contract with Dietrich. Upon learning that service would be discontinued, Dietrich contacted Perfetti Trucking and Mawson & Mawson but neither of these carriers was capable of providing sufficient equipment to meet its shipping and delivery schedules.

Since the supporting shipper's existing carrier has terminated its service and since the shipper has made efforts to secure service from existing carriers but has been unable to obtain adequate service, we believe that sufficient evidence has been presented to warrant a grant of emergency temporary authority; THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED: That the application for emergency temporary authority be and is hereby approved granting the following right:

To transport, as a Class D carrier, steel building products, and materials, equipment and supplies used in the manufacture and distribution of steel building products, for Dietrich Industries, Inc., from its facilities located in the township of West Wheatfield, Indiana County, to points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the applicant shall file an acceptable tariff.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the authority granted herein will be effective pending disposition of the temporary authority application.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That our action in this matter will have no bearing on the final disposition of the applications for temporary and permanent authority.
