SECTION 1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

ITEM 20 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

Except as otherwise provided herein for rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS, IN USE, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory), revisions there and reissues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article.

ITEM 40 - HOURLY RATES

Rates begin at time of arrival and ends at completion. An associated travel time charge will be added as stated under Note AA on Item 300.

ITEM 50 - ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

All tolls, parking fees and other out of pocket expenses will be the responsibility of the customer and added to the carrier's charges.

ITEM 60 - DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATION POLICY

Reservations that require deposit will be at a rate of 20% of costs. Deposits are subject to forfeiture of 50% if schedule moving date is cancelled more than 15 days but less than 30 days prior to the move date and forfeiture of the total amount if cancelled 15 days or less of move date.

SECTION 2 ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

Subject to Notes AA, 1 and 2 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2 and 3.

> A flat charge based on one and one half hours at the applicable transportation rate shown in Columns 2 or 3 when distance from original point of origin to final destination is more than 10 miles but not exceeding 20 miles.

A flat charge based on two hours at the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2 or 3 when distance from original point of origin to final destination is more than 20 miles but not to exceed 40 miles.
