To Whom It May Concern:

On May 30 and August 31, 1995, the Commission sent billings to your company for your assessment for our 1995-96 fiscal year. You have made no payment on the total assessment of \$1,357.00.

You are directed to pay the outstanding amount of your assessment by January 5, 1996. Your check or money order, payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, should be forwarded to Carmon Bass, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265. Failure to make timely payment will result in the institution of an action to cancel your certificate of public convenience.

In the event that your certificate is cancelled, additional action will follow. Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S.A. §510(c), we may request the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to revoke the vehicle registrations of all your motor vehicles licensed in Pennsylvania. Also, we will notify the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue that you are no longer eligible for sales and use tax exemption as a common carrier under our jurisdiction. Finally, we will notify your insurance carrier that your company cannot lawfully provide service within this Commonwealth.



Please be informed that when a prospective shipper requests moving and before an order for service is prepared, the household goods carrier shall furnish the prospective shipper with a statement entitled "Information for Shippers" as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.121(a) of which the bottom part has to include the name of the shipper, the date certified that the information for shipper was furnished to this person and the signature of the carrier representative. The carrier shall retain a copy of this certification with the shipping order.

The following eleven (11) moves reflect violations of 52 Pa. Code §31.122(2), for failure to use and execute a proper form for estimates of charges titled "Estimated Cost of Services":

- (b) Gary Kuboresak, December 20, 1996
- (c) Janet Houck, March 3, 1997



- (d) Joe Kochuba, March 28, 1997

The shipper shall be given a completed estimate of charges on the proper form as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.122(2), even if an estimate is given over the telephone in advance.

The following two (2) moves reflect charges exceeding the estimate by more than 10%:

- (a) Dan Calabria, December 9, 1996
- (b) Mary Kline, April 22, 1997

A common carrier of household goods in use shall file with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Bureau of Transportation and Safety, Motor Carrier Services and Enforcement Division, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, a quarterly report containing instances wherein charges exceeded the estimate by more than 10% with the explanation of the reasons for the variances in accordance with 52 Pa. Code §31.124. As of the date of this letter, no such report has been received by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

The following three (3) moves reflect violations of 66 Pa. C.S. §1303, by charging a lesser rate than that specified in your household goods tariff on file with this Commission:

- (a) In the household goods move made for Judy and Rich Dye on November 29, 1996, you charged \$1,092.95, as opposed to the correct charge of \$1,104.38, resulting in an approximate undercharge of \$11.43.
- (b) In the household goods move made for Diane Wenrich on March 31 through April 2, 1997, you charged \$2,046.53, as opposed to the correct charge of \$2,421.86, resulting in an approximate undercharge of \$375.33.
- (c) In the household goods move made for Jack Moyer on May 13, 1997, you charged \$568.28, as opposed to the correct charge of \$603.20, resulting in an approximate undercharge of \$34.92.

The following move reflects a violation of 66 Pa. C.S. §1303, by charging a greater rate than that specified in your household goods tariff on file with this Commission:


- (a) In the household goods move made for Frank Domzalski on May 13, 1997, you charged \$550.86, as opposed to the correct charge of \$446.83, resulting in an approximate overcharge of \$104.03.

Continued operations, as described above, may subject you to penalties which may include the assessment of fines up to \$1,000 per violation.

- (a) Motor Carrier rate increase in accordance with 52 PA Code §23.67. Tristate Household Goods Conference, Inc., on behalf of all participating members of Berks County, Glose Moving & Storage, Inc., L & J Moving & Storage, Inc., and Worldwide Transportation Experts, Inc., t/a Fritz Moving Company, Inc.
- (b) The 6th Revised Page 76 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50, applies to all participating carriers furnishing household goods in use service originating in Berks County and transported distances of forty (40) miles or less as more thoroughly described in the official tariff. Tristate Household Goods Conference, Inc is requesting a 4.3% increase in the hourly charges to cover projected increases in carrier's wage and insurance expense. Three (3) carriers in Berks County are subject to this tariff. The proposed rates are to become effective December 6, 2004.
- (c) The Bureau recommends that the 6th Revised Page 76 to Tariff Freight Pa. PUC No. 50, as filed by Tristate Household Goods Conference, Inc. be permitted to become effective December 6, 2004.
