L&J officially started business on October 10, 1990 as L&J Moving and Storage Inc. Our primary purpose at that time was to provide office moves and household goods moving and storage for companies and the general public. We provided moving services intrastate (L&J) and interstate (agent for northAmerican Van Lines). To better service our customers in 1994 we changes our affiliation from northAmerican Van Lines to National Van Lines. At that time we also started providing moving services internationally. We maintain this relationship today.

Over the years we found it necessary to diversify in order to reduce the seasonality of household goods moving and also better the company's stability and profitability. We began servicing primarily the retail industry with transportation of store fixtures on a nationwide basis. This has been so successful that in 2007 we decided to rename the company to better identify our services to the public. We now operate two separate divisions within our company L&J Moving and Storage and L&J Logistics. The merger of Blanket Transportation (brokering company) is the next step in our continued goal to be able to offer our customers "Total Transportation Solutions".






