I would like to appeal the decision of dismissing
my case #C-2015-2478698 AGAINST P.E.CO.

ON August 13TH when I had a hearing with P.E.CO AND
THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION I WAS TOLD THAT I WOULD RECEIVE A
TRANSCRIPT OF THE HEARING WITHIN 30 DAYS. WHICH I NEVER RECEIVED. HOWEVER
AT THAT HEARING I WAS INFORMED THAT EVELLE RODRIGUEZ CALLED AND USED MY
NAME AND ESTABLISHED ELECTRIC AT 1022 WYOMING AVENUE, SECOND FLOOR GYMNASIUM
THAT I NOW LIVE THERE WHICH WAS NOT TRUE THE ENCLOSED POLICE REPORT
ESTABLISHES THAT FACT. WHEN P.E.CO GAVE HER ELECTRIC IN MY NAME THEY DIDN'T
EVEN KNOW THAT IT WASN'T MR. CALLING. MY SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER WAS GIVEN
TO A UNKNOWN CALLER WHICH WAS ESTABLISHED WHEN I TOOK HER TO COURT
FOR THE CHARGES TO MY 4036 ADDRESS BILL. THE ORDER IS ALSO ENCLOSED AS PROOF.
OF THE LENGTH THAT WAS AGREED OF EVELLE RODRIGUEZ PAYMENT WOULD BE 112
PAYMENTS OF \$30.00 MONTHLY. P.E.CO EXPECTED ME TO PAY NOT JUST
HER BILL FROM WYOMING AVENUE. BUT THE INTEREST AND PENALTIES
WHICH I CANNOT AFFORD AND I HAVE BEEN PUT IN AN UNFAIR
POSITION WITH MAINTAINING MY P.E.CO SERVICE BECAUSE OF THIS
INJUSTICE OF FRAUD. I NEVER AGREED TO LET HER USE MY
NAME SHE ASKED BUT I NEVER AGREED AND I DON'T
PLAN TO BE HOODWINKED INTO PAYING A BILL FOR ELECTRIC
W/ INTEREST AND PENALTIES BECAUSE OF THIS INJUSTICE. I WOULD
LIKE TO APPEAL AND HAVE ALL OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW
JUDGES REVIEW JUDGE FRED HARRIS. DECISION I WAS DISMISS-
ED FROM THE HEARING WHILE P.E.CO REMAINED WITH THE JUDGE.
AND I FEEL THE DISMISSAL WAS BASED ON THE HEARING HEARD AFTER

MY HEARING ON AUGUST 13TH WHICH WAS ALSO UNFAIR AND UNJUST!
AND WHEN I TOOK EVELLE RODRIGUEZ TO SMITH CAMMS SHE ADMITS
TO USING MY NAME FRAUDULENTLY. AND THAT SHE DIDN'T HAVE MY SOCIAL
SECURITY #. SO I FEEL FEAR PUT ME IN THIS SITUATION BECAUSE I ALREADY
HAD ELECTRIC ESTABLISHED IN MY NAME. AT 4036 N. FRANKLIN WHEN THEY
CONTACTED ME IT WAS WITH A SHUT OFF NOTICE WHICH I CONTINUED TO RECEIVE BASED
ON A \$4000.00 BILL!

You are a party in a case pending in the Philadelphia Municipal Court. This letter is to inform you that mediation is available to you as an option for resolving your dispute.

Mediation is an opportunity to meet with the other party, and with the assistance of a court-designated mediator, develop a mutually agreeable solution. The mediator will not decide the outcome of your dispute. The mediator will act as an impartial third party and assist you to reach a settlement you consider fair and just.

The Mediation Service is Free and Voluntary

If you reach an agreement, the terms will be entered in the court record and you will not have to appear in court. The agreement will have the same effect as a judge's decision. It is final and cannot be appealed.

If you do not reach a satisfactory agreement, you will keep your scheduled court date. At that time, the case will be heard by a judge.

Your case has been **tentatively scheduled** for Mediation on **12/14/15 at 10:00 AM**, in room 600, 6th floor, 1339 Chestnut Street.

Mediation is voluntary; therefore, this mediation session will take place only if you contact our unit.

Some Advantages of Mediation

1. Any agreement reached will have the same effect as a judge's decision
2. There is no appeal of the agreement since you will only enter into an agreement that is satisfactory to your needs.
3. The mediation session is informal and private
4. About 75% of mediation sessions conclude in a signed agreement.


