





ARTICLE 6 shall read as follows: 6. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than eight nor more than 15 persons who are members of the corporation. Members of the Board of Directors shall be elected by and serve at the will of the Class II members.

ARTICLE 8 is amended to read as follows: 8. Class I members - Class I membership shall be open to any person of legal age who files a written application which is approved by a majority vote of the West Lawn Lions Club. Class II members - Class II membership shall be open to any member of the West Lawn Lions Club who files a written application. Voting rights in the corporation shall be vested in and confined to Class II members.

ARTICLE 10 shall be added, to read as follows:  
10. The Articles of Incorporation shall be amended only by a majority vote of the West Lawn Lions Club at a meeting held pursuant to notice given in accordance to law. The corporation may adopt ByLaws. The ByLaws must be approved a majority vote of the Class II members. Amendments to the ByLaws shall be made only if approved by a majority vote of the Class II members.

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE SAID COURT:

The Petition of Western Berks Ambulance Association respectfully represents:

1. That your Petitioner is Western Berks Ambulance Association, that it is a corporation formed under the Act of 1933, May 5, P.L. 289, known as the Nonprofit Corporation Law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, pursuant to a Decree of Incorporation entered by your Honorable Court on October 2, 1961, to No. 18 October Term 1961 A.D., the original Articles of Incorporation having been recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Berks County in Charter Book Volume 18, Page 197, on October 5, 1961.

3. That Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of Western Berks Ambulance Association were filed in the Office of the Prothonotary of Berks County, Pennsylvania, on December 15, 1964.

4. That the aforesaid Articles of Amendment are submitted to your Honorable Court herewith accompanied by a certified copy of the Resolution authorizing the proposed amendments and proofs of the advertisement of your Petitioner's intention to apply to your Honorable Court for an amendment of its Charter in the Reading Eagle-Times and the Berks County Law Journal on January 14, 1965.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays your Honorable Court to enter a Decree approving the aforesaid Articles of Amendment



R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by  
WESTERN BERKS AMBULANCE ASSOCIATION, a nonprofit corporation  
organized and doing business under the laws of the Commonwealth  
of Pennsylvania, that the Articles of Incorporation of the said  
corporation be and they are hereby amended as follows:

1. Article 3 of the Articles of Incorporation of the  
said corporation is hereby amended by adding to the present  
Article 3 the following language:

"No compensation or payment shall ever be  
paid or made to any member, officer, director,  
creator or organizer of this corporation, or  
substantial contributor to it, except as a  
reasonable allowance for actual expenditures  
or services actually made or rendered to or for  
this corporation; and neither the whole nor any  
part or portion of the assets or net earnings,  
current or accumulated, of this corporation,  
shall ever be distributed to or divided among any  
such persons; provided further, that neither the  
whole nor any part or portion of such assets or  
net earnings shall ever be used for, accrue to, or  
inure to the benefit of any member or private  
individual within the meaning of Section 501 (c)  
(3) of the Internal Revenue Code."

2. The Articles of Incorporation of the said  
corporation are hereby amended by the addition of a ninth  
article as follows:

"In the event of the dissolution of this  
corporation, the Directors shall, after  
paying or making provision for payment of  
all of the liabilities of the corporation,  
distribute all of the assets of the corporation  
in such manner or to such organization or  
organizations for charitable, educational,  
religious or scientific purposes as shall at  
the time qualify as an exempt organization or  
organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the  
Internal Revenue Code, or to the federal, state  
or local government for the purposes of this  
corporation or for other public purposes, as the  
Board of Directors shall determine."

the proper officers of the corporation are authorized to  
institute and carry to completion the necessary and appropriate  
legal proceedings to effectuate the foregoing amendments.





