RESTRICTIVE AMENDMENT AND STIPULATION

In accordance with the Rules of Practice of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission"), Applicant, Tyran Wheaton t/a En Route Medical Transport, and Protestants, EZ Taxi, LLC, Amigo Cab, LLC, and Express Taxi, LLC ("Protestants") enter into the following Fourth Restrictive Amendment and Stipulation:

1. Applicant hereby restrictively amends its Application so that the operating authority sought by the Application shall read as follows:


for the right to transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in paratransit service, *restricted to wheelchair transportation*, from points in the Counties of Berks, Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Lancaster, Lehigh, Montgomery, Northampton and Philadelphia, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.


2. Based on the Restrictive Amendment set forth in Paragraph 1 above and conditioned upon its acceptance by the Commission and any Order issued in this case being consistent therewith, Protestants EZ Taxi, LLC, Amigo Cab, LLC, and Express Taxi, LLC hereby withdraw their respective protests, subject to the following conditions:
(1) if any aspect of this Restrictive Amendment and Stipulation is not approved by the

Commission for any reason (excepting only the Denial of the Application in its entirety), the Protestants' protest shall be deemed immediately reinstated, and (2) if any aspect of this Restrictive Amendment is not approved by the Commission for any reason (excepting only the Denial of the Application in its entirety), Protestants shall have the right to: (a) present evidence in an on-the-record proceeding in opposition to the Application, (b) request reconsideration of the Application before the Commission, and/or (c) appeal such approval before any appropriate Appellate Court and Applicant stipulates that it will not raise any objection as to party status and/or standing of any Protestant in such proceeding.

3. Protestants desire to remain a party of record so as to receive copies of any orders issued by the Commission in the proceeding.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of the promises mutually set forth above, counsel for the parties have executed this Restrictive Amendment.
