Your application has been reviewed and published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. No comments have been received; Therefore,


YOU ARE ADVISED THAT:

Form E, evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance.
Form H, evidence of cargo liability insurance.
A copy of registration to comply with Fictitious Name Act.
4. If you fail to comply with the requirements contained in paragraph No. 3 above, within 60 days of the date of this letter, this application will be dismissed.

If you have not submitted a copy of current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review to be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date this letter is entered.
