COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement Prosecutory Staff hereby represents as follows:

1. Nasser Limousine Service, LLC, Respondent, maintains its principal place of business at 4751 Birney Avenue, Moosic, Pennsylvania, 18507.
2. That Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission on August 15, 2005 at Application Docket No. A-00120555 authorizing transportation of passengers in limousine authority.
3. That on September 1, 2015, the Respondent permitted a certain 2005 Lincoln bearing license number JNM-4914 and having Vehicle Identification No. 1LNHM84W65Y669026 to be operated.
4. That on September 1, 2015, PUC Scranton Motor Carrier Enforcement District Office Supervisor, Andrew J. Turriziani, conducted a random inspection on the above-referenced vehicle.
5. That Respondent was advised by letter dated June 22, 2012 that no vehicles over 8 model years old may be used in service without obtaining a waiver of regulations.
6. That Respondent, by operating a vehicle more than 8 model years old without obtaining a waiver of regulations, violated 52 Pa. Code §29.333(e). The penalty is \$500 per day, for a total of \$500.00.
