Dear Respondent:

On November 7, 2013, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement instituted a complaint against Best Rate Limousine, LLC (respondent) alleging that respondent was advertising discounted rates that did not comply with the approved tariff; that vehicles over 8 model years old were in service without obtaining a waiver, in violation of 66 Pa. C.S. §1103, 52 Pa. Code §29.314(d). The total penalty for the violations is one thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,750).

Respondent was duly notified that, if an answer was not filed within twenty (20) days of receipt of the complaint, the penalty would be imposed.

The complaint and notice were served on respondent on November 7, 2013, which was returned by the U.S. Post Office on November 14, 2013. The complaint was reserved by first class mail on November 21, 2013. On January 17, 2014 the complaint was hand delivered to respondent by Enforcement Officer L. Blank, a duly authorized officer of this Commission; and, more than thirty (30) days later, no response has been received from respondent.

Therefore, the allegations in the complaint are admitted and the complaint is sustained.

Respondent, within twenty (20) days from the date of service of this letter, shall pay a fine of one thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$1,750) by certified check or money order payable to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265, as provided in the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§3301 and 3315, shall cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq., and the Regulations of this Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1, et seq.
