



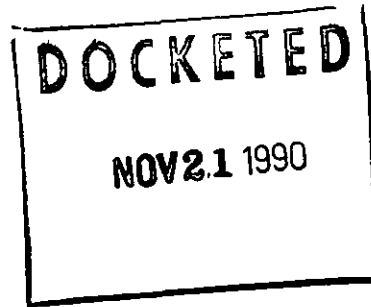

In review of our records it has been found that you have still not complied with the Commission's order dated May 24, 1990.


In order to process your approved application it is necessary to file with the Commission a tariff, contract and insurance filings.
