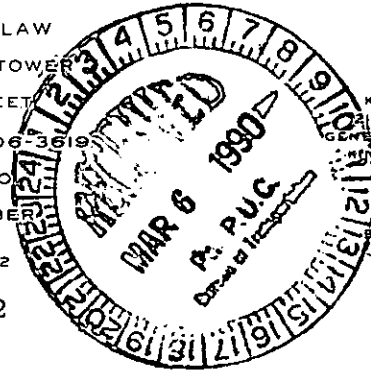

AGREEMENT OF SALE

THIS AGREEMENT made this 31st day of January, 1990 by and between BRADWAY TRUCKING, INC. ("SELLER"), a New Jersey corporation, and BRADWAY, INC. ("PURCHASER"), a New Jersey corporation.

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, SELLER is a certificated common carrier of property by motor vehicle and holds operating rights issued by the Interstate Commerce Commission ("ICC") at Docket MC-153002 ("ICC Operating Authority") and by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Pa PUC") at Docket No. A-106672 and Folders and Amendments thereunder ("Pa PUC Operating Authority"); and

WHEREAS, PURCHASER is a New Jersey corporation formed for the purpose of engaging in the motor carrier business; and

WHEREAS, SELLER has agreed to sell to PURCHASER and PURCHASER has agreed to purchase all of SELLER's Pa PUC Operating Authority and all of SELLER'S ICC Operating Authority upon the terms and conditions set forth hereinafter.

NOW, THEREFORE, SELLER and PURCHASER, in consideration of and reliance upon their mutual promises and the warranties and covenants herein contained, and intending to be legally bound hereby, agree as follows:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

I. PROPERTY TO BE SOLD AND PURCHASED.

1.1 SELLER agrees to sell to PURCHASER and PURCHASER agrees to buy from SELLER, free and clear of all liens, encumbrances, security interests and other charges and

claims, all of the Pa PUC Operating Authority and all of SELLERS ICC Operating Authority, together referred to hereinafter as the ("Operating Rights").

II. PURCHASE PRICE AND PAYMENT.

2.1 PURCHASER shall pay to SELLER in consideration for the Operating Rights the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) to be paid in cash or by immediately available funds at Closing (as hereinafter defined).

III. JURISDICTION OF REGULATORY BODIES; APPLICATIONS;

3.1 SELLER and PURCHASER understand and agree that the transaction hereby contemplated is subject to the jurisdiction of both the ICC and the Pa PUC.

3.2 PURCHASER shall promptly cause an application, petition for exemption or other appropriate pleading(s) to be prepared and filed with the ICC and the Pa PUC and diligently prosecuted in order to secure such exemptions or authorizations as are necessary to permit the transfer of the Operating Rights to PURCHASER.

3.3 Regulatory Denial or Modification.

If either the ICC or the Pa PUC fails to approve or exempt the transfer of the Operating Rights or any portion thereof, or if the transfer of any of the rights is approved or exempted subject to conditions or limitations which materially vary or alter the terms of

this Agreement, the parties may terminate this Agreement and declare the same null and void or may modify the terms hereof.

IV. CLOSING AND CLOSING DATE

4.1 The event at which the sale and purchase of the Operating Rights shall be consummated is the "Closing". Closing shall take place at the offices of Rubin Quinn Moss & Heaney, 1800 Penn Mutual Tower, 510 Walnut Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on a mutually convenient date within thirty (30) days following the approval or exemption of the transaction by both the ICC and the Pa PUC.

As noted in the application, Transferee is a newly formed corporation which is affiliated with Transferor. The Transferee intends to adopt and maintain the intensive safety program currently operated by Transferor. The corporate officers of Transferee are also officers of Transferor and are familiar with the safety program.

The importance of safe operations is emphasized to all employees from the time they are interviewed for hiring, during their initial training, and throughout their continued employment with the company. Regular safety meetings are held with the employees to discuss not only safety regulations and requirements, but also recent developments in all aspects of safe operations. Employees are subject to disciplinary action for failure to follow the proper safety procedures.

In addition to employee-related programs, we also stress that our equipment be in peak operating condition. All vehicles are subject to a preventative maintenance program designed to meet this goal. Also, all of the equipment is inspected daily and any defects found are listed and corrected before the unit is used again.

Although Applicant has not been assigned a safety rating by the United States Department of Transportation, Transferor has a satisfactory rating.

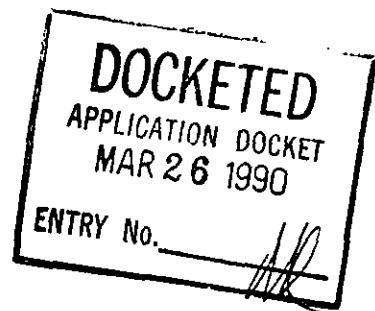
