Please consider this letter and attachments in response to your letter of December 23, 2015.

1. Reference Application, Section 2.b, Certificate of Incorporation – Applicant Failed to provide signed and dated Articles of Incorporation or Incorporation Application Documentation. Please provide the above requested documentation. Applicant can elect to mark submitted information as confidential.
 - a. I enclose the original articles of incorporation for the predecessor corporation (PAISIG, 1995), and the name change decree to PAISBOA Services Corporation from PAISIG-PAISBOA Sub.
2. Reference Application, Section 6.a, Certificate of Service - Applicant failed to provide a Certificate of Service verifying its EGS Application was served on the Bureau of Investigation & Enforcement (BI&E). If application was not served on BI&E, please do so, and provide an updated Certificate of Service that includes BI&E.
 - a. Attached is an updated certificate of service (Appendix C) indicating that a copy of the updated application was furnished to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement as requested.
3. Reference Application, Section 6.e, Customers – The applicant stated that they intend to provide service to Mixed Meter customers as well as Large Commercial. The Mixed Meter option is intended for applicants that will take title to electricity. TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
PHILADELPHIA AREA INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS HEALTH INSURANCE GROUP

The corporation is incorporated under the Nonprofit Corporation Law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for the following purpose or purposes:

To provide a medium through which qualified organizations can obtain health insurance coverage with the security and purchasing advantage of a group.

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, literary, scientific, religious and educational purposes provided for under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purposes.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the preparation or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

In the event of dissolution of this corporation, its assets shall be distributable only to organizations which enjoy exempt status in accordance with the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

However, if the named recipient is not then in existence or no longer a qualified distributee, or unwilling or unable to accept the distribution, then the assets of this corporation shall be distributed to a fund, foundation or corporation organized and operated exclusively for the purposes specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
