

To Whom It May Concern:

On May 30 and August 31, 1995, the Commission sent billings to your company for your assessment for our 1995-96 fiscal year. You have made no payment on the total assessment of \$977.00.

You are directed to pay the outstanding amount of your assessment by January 5, 1996. Your check or money order, payable to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, should be forwarded to Carmon Bass, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265. Failure to make timely payment will result in the institution of an action to cancel your certificate of public convenience.

In the event that your certificate is cancelled, additional action will follow. Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S.A. §510(c), we may request the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to revoke the vehicle registrations of all your motor vehicles licensed in Pennsylvania. Also, we will notify the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue that you are no longer eligible for sales and use tax exemption as a common carrier under our jurisdiction. Finally, we will notify your insurance carrier that your company cannot lawfully provide service within this Commonwealth.

Dear Ms. Stewart:

On January 26, 1996, a Household Mover Review was conducted by Enforcement Officer Jerome M. Todaro of our Pittsburgh District Office. The household goods moves which were reviewed took place between the dates of April 14, 1995, and December 22, 1995.

A review of your records disclosed the following violations:

1. In one (1) household move, made for Richard Bergman on June 8, 1995, you failed to maintain a copy of written estimate, as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.122(1)(2).
2. In the household moves made for Denise Grisnik on May 30, 1995, and Terry Callen on November 11, 1995, the charges exceeded the estimate by more than ten (10) percent. You failed to file a quarterly report for the second and fourth quarters of 1995, as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.124(a).
3. In the household move made for Richard Bergman on June 8, 1995, you also failed to maintain two copies of the weight tickets in your file with the copy of receipt or bill of lading, as required by 52 Pa. Code §31.125.
