
Dear Jim:

On October 10, 2001, Suzanne Diehl Stewart t/d/b/a Diehl Moving and Storage filed a Petition for Reinstatement of its certificate of authority at the above-captioned docket. 
Gentlemen:

PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT OF OPERATING AUTHORITY

The petition of Suzanne Diehl Stewart respectfully represents:

1. Your petitioner is Suzanne Diehl Stewart, t/d/b/a Diehl Moving and Storage, with a mailing address of P. O. Box 1866, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania.

2. The petitioner operates a moving and storage business under authority from the Public Utility Commission issued at the above number.

3. By letter dated July 31, 2001 from the Public Utility Commission, the petitioner was advised of the suspension of operating authority effective August 2, 2001 for expired insurance.

4. Effective August 1, 2001, your petitioner changed insurance carriers and obtained insurance coverage from Connecticut Indemnity Company and Progressive Insurance Company, who obtained certain coverages for the petitioner through Mountain Laurel Assurance Co.

5. A copy of the suspension notice was provided to the petitioner's insurance agent who indicated the proper filing would

be made.

6. On August 27, 2001, the Commission filed a complaint to revoke petitioner's operating authority for failure to have insurance coverage. The complaint indicated that the matter could be resolved by filing proof of insurance.

7. The petitioner called her insurance agent and then faxed him a copy of the complaint. In reply, she received a copy of a fax to Progressive Insurance Company from her agent requesting the proper filings be made with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. A copy of the fax is enclosed as Exhibit A.

8. By letter dated September 15, 2001, the insurance agent, U. S. Casualty Corp, was advised that the insurance filings had been made, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

9. By order dated October 3, 2001, the petitioner was notified that her certificate of public convenience had been cancelled for failure to provide proof of insurance.

10. Subsequent investigation by petitioner revealed that the filing had been made under her mother's name, Esther J. Diehl, who is listed as an additional insured under petitioner's policy, rather than under petitioner's name. A copy of the incorrect filing is attached as Exhibit C.

11. On October 9, 2001, Mountain Laurel Assurance Co, filed an amended Form E to correct the insured's name with insurance effective from August 1, 2001. A copy is attached as Exhibit D.

12. On October 9, 2001, Connecticut Indemnity Co. filed Form H showing the proper name on the insurance with coverage

effective from August 1, 2001. A copy is attached as Exhibit E.

13. At all times since August 1, 2001, the petitioner has had proper insurance coverage, but due to clerical error or oversight the insurance companies failed to file the proper forms with the Commission.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner respectfully requests this Honorable Commission to reinstate her certificate of public convenience.




