BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 2, 1996, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety Prosecutory Staff instituted a complaint against GDP Associates, Inc.. (respondent), alleging failure to maintain proper evidence of current insurance in violation of the Public Utility Code.

The Respondent was duly notified that, if an answer was not filed within twenty (20) days of the receipt of the complaint, the Bureau would request the Commission to enter an order revoking respondent's certificate of public convenience.

An answer to the complaint was filed by the respondent on August 12, 1996, stating that the respondent had sold all of its assets on March 25, 1996, and that the respondent no longer has need for the certificate of public convenience.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:
