Dear Mr. Long:

This letter is in response to the correspondence of April 5, 1999, sent to James J. McNulty, Secretary, by Clair Albert Godissart, regarding the certificate of public convenience issued by this Commission at A-00111775.

Please be advised that all common carriers holding a certificate of public convenience issued by this Commission must maintain acceptable evidence of insurance on file with the Commission at all times. Failure to maintain acceptable evidence of insurance will result in the cancellation of the certificate of public convenience.

If the certificate of public convenience authorizes the transportation of property, the Commission will not reinstate a certificate of public convenience once it has been canceled. The only option available would be to file a new application and submit the filing fee of \$100.00.

If it is your intention to resume operations prior to January 26, 2000, I would suggest that a letter be forwarded to the Commission, requesting that the Commission grant a voluntary suspension. Approval of the request would suspend the certificate of public convenience for one (1) year from the date of the cancellation of your insurance, January 26, 1999. Should you determine that a voluntary suspension is the route you wish to take, forward your written request to the above address.

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Dear Mr. Long:

This will acknowledge receipt of your correspondence of April 15, 1999, on behalf of Edward Long, which requests that the certificate of public convenience at A-0011775, be suspended.

After review of the record, it has been determined that a grant of a voluntary suspension for one (1) year is appropriate. The voluntary suspension is effective from January 26, 1999, the date your bodily injury and property damage liability insurance and cargo insurance was canceled. The voluntary suspension will terminate on January 25, 2000. No service shall be rendered during the suspension.

Prior to resuming operations, the Commission should be notified in writing of your intention to resume operations. Acceptable evidence of insurance should also be submitted to the Commission prior to resuming operations.
