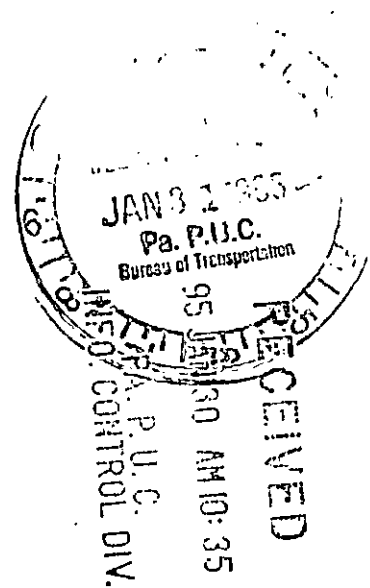

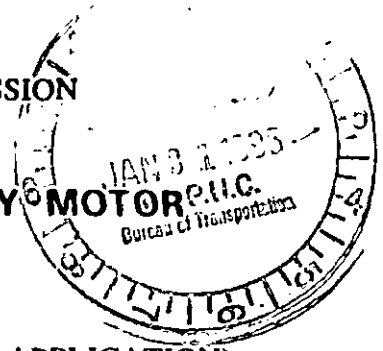

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
GDP ASSOCIATES, INC.

The undersigned, intending to form a corporation under the Pennsylvania Business Corporation Law of 1988 (15 Pa. C.S. §§ 1101 et seq.), as amended, hereby certifies as follows:

- FIRST.** The name of the Corporation is *GDP Associates, Inc.*
- SECOND.** The address of the Corporation's initial registered office in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is *1112 Windfall Road, St. Marys, PA 15857*
- THIRD.** The Corporation is incorporated under the provisions of the Business Corporation Law of 1988 (15 Pa. C.S. §§ 1101 et seq.).
- FOURTH.** The Corporation shall have the authority to issue *1,000 shares of common stock par value \$10.00 per share*. The holders of common stock shall have one vote per share and shall not be entitled to cumulate their votes in the election of directors.
- FIFTH.** The name and address of the incorporator is *Gary H. McQuone, 4990 USX Tower, 600 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15219*.
- SIXTH.** The Corporation shall not issue any shares of common stock of the Corporation without first offering such shares pro rata at the same price and on the same terms and conditions on which the proposed issuance is to be made, to the holders of common stock of the Corporation.
- SEVENTH.** A director of the Corporation shall not be personally liable for monetary damages for any action taken, or any failure to take any action unless the director has breached or failed to perform the duties of his or her office under 15 Pa. C.S. § 511 and § 1721 and such breach or failure to perform constitutes self-dealing, willful misconduct or recklessness; provided, however, that the foregoing provision shall not eliminate or limit (i) the responsibility or liability of a director pursuant to any criminal statute, or (ii) the liability of a director for the payment of taxes pursuant to local, state or Federal law. Any repeal, modification or adoption of any provision inconsistent with this Article SEVENTH, shall be prospective only, and neither the repeal or modification of this Article nor the adoption of any provision inconsistent with this Article shall adversely affect any limitation on the personal liability of a director of the Corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification or the adoption of such inconsistent provision.
