Dear Ms. Daigle:

On September 16, 2002, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety instituted a complaint against Engles Trucking Services, respondent, alleging respondent was operating without having evidence of current insurance on file with this Commission, a violation of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §501(c).

The complaint and notice were served on respondent on September 19, 2002. By Answer dated September 19, 2002, respondent stated that she was not aware that the PUC did not have a copy of respondent's cargo insurance. Respondent further stated that she does not deny the allegations, but once she was made aware of the matter, she quickly took care of it. The carrier now has appropriate evidence of insurance on file with the Commission and is in compliance with Commission requirements. We will impose the monetary penalty, but will not revoke respondent's Certificate of Public Convenience.

Therefore, the allegations in the complaint are admitted and the complaint is sustained.

Respondent, within twenty (20) days from the date of service of this letter, shall pay a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) by certified check or money order payable to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265, as provided in the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§3301 and 3315, shall cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq., and the Regulations of this Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1, et seq.
