The above referenced application has been assigned for review without an oral hearing. In order to reach a determination on the application, you are being required to file verified statements in accordance with 52 Pa. Code §3.381(e)(1). You will be required to file:

- A. VERIFIED STATEMENT OF APPLICANT.
- B. VERIFIED STATEMENTS IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION.

The verified statements should be in paragraph form. Each heading contained in the attached minimum outline should be a separate section or paragraph.

You should be aware of the fact that the verified statements will be reviewed based on the Commission's decision in the Application of Bluebird Coach Lines, Inc. A-00088807, F. 2, Am-K, which indicates: (1) the supporting witnesses must give evidence which is probative and relevant to the application proceeding; (2) the supporting witnesses must identify Pennsylvania origin and destination points between which they require transportation and those points must correspond with the scope of the operating territory specified in the application including requests for vice versa authority; and (3) the number of witnesses which will represent a cross section of the public on the issue of need will vary with the breadth of the intended territory and commodity description.

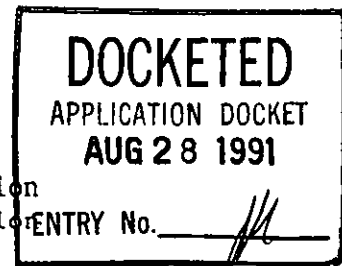
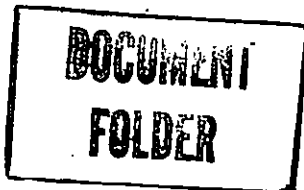
You are being granted an initial thirty (30) days to file verified statements. They will be due on or before September 27, 1991.


Dear Mr. Hoshour:

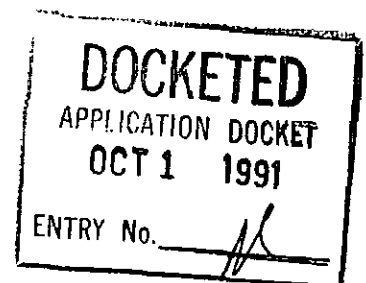
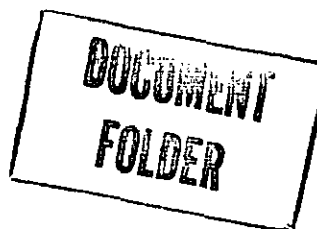


Dear Mr. Hoshour:

In view of the foregoing, I am requesting an additional thirty (30) day extension within which to file the verified statements. Hopefull, no further extension of time will be required.

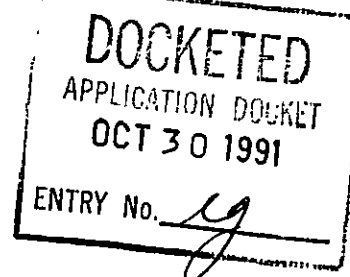

VERIFIED STATEMENT OF APPLICANT



1. The legal name of the Applicant is Wright's Meat Packing, Inc. and its domicile is at Wright Lane, Fombell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania 16123.
2. The person making this statement for the Applicant is William L. Wright, who is President of Wright's Meat Packing, Inc.
3. The Applicant is not affiliated with any other carriers.
4. The authority sought is for permission to haul, for compensation, bones, grease, dead livestock and other livestock related offal from slaughter houses, retail meat markets (including supermarkets), farms, livestock auctions and other establishments where livestock is processed or sold between points in the counties of Beaver, Butler, Lawrence, Allegheny, Mercer and Armstrong, Pennsylvania.
5. The Applicant has no currently authorized operations.
6. No duplicating authority will result from the grant of authority.
7. No dual operations will result from the grant of authority.
8. Adequate terminal facilities will be provided at Wright Lane, Fombell, Beaver County, Pennsylvania.
9. The pertinent equipment that will be initially used if the authority is granted will be a 1988 Model C-70 Chevrolet truck which is owned by William L. Wright and is currently leased to the Applicant.
10. The Applicant currently has a safety program which includes monthly inspections of equipment, constant maintenance of all equipment and periodic safety meetings with employees who would be authorized to operate the equipment.
11. It is believed that the supporting witnesses currently receive services proposed to be rendered by Applicant through other haulers that is provided by the supporting witnesses themselves.
12. The type of service to be offered is to haul, for compensation, bones, grease, dead livestock and other livestock related offal from slaughter houses, retail meat markets (including supermarkets), farms, livestock auctions and other establishments where livestock is processed or sold in the counties of Beaver, Butler, Lawrence, Allegheny, Mercer and Armstrong, Pennsylvania to rendering plants situated within a 150 mile radius of the Applicant's domicile.

13. The latest financial data is attached hereto. Like information for the current year will be supplied upon receipt.
14. The Service provided will create some empty miles from the rendering plant back to Applicant's domicile. It is not anticipated that there will be any backhauls.
15. In addition to the product hauled from the supporting witnesses and other customers to be obtained, Applicant expects to haul from its own facility approximately thirty (30) beef sets, forty (40) hog sets, five thousand (5,000) pounds of fat and twenty-five hundred (2,500) pounds of bones per week.

This letter is a follow up to our telephone conversations regarding the above captioned application. In our last conversation, I indicated that the Commission would require a written clarification of Paragraph 12 of the applicant's verified statement, in which the applicant states its intention to provide transportation to rendering plants situated within a 150 mile radius of the applicant's domicile.

The applicant's verified statement, Paragraph 15, describes transportation the applicant will provide on its own behalf. As I indicated in our conversation, private carriage rendered by a certificated common carrier is governed by the court's decision in Makovsky Bros. v. Pa. P.U.C., 55 Pa. Ct. 435 (1980); and the Application of Gene Fuller Homes, Inc., A-00108928; Petition for Reconsideration and Amendment of Order entered May 17, 1990, order adopted August 2, 1990.

I am in receipt of your letter of December 10, 1991, in which the clarification was provided.

In an earlier conversation, I advised that additional information would be required from the three supporting shippers. None of the supporting shippers have indicated any specific destinations for their shipments. Each of the supporting shippers refers only to deliveries to rendering plants. The Commission has in prior proceedings denied applications because the supporting shippers failed to indicate specific destinations of shipments. This information has not been provided the Commission.
