COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Transportation and Safety and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety Prosecutory Staff hereby represents as follows:

1. That Glamour Moving Co., Inc., respondent, maintains its principal place of business at 1990 Meadow Drive, Westminster, MD 21158.

2. That respondent filed an application for a certificate of public convenience, which was docketed by this Commission on May 25, 1995, at Application Docket No. A-00112271 and was subsequently withdrawn by the applicant on February 13, 1996. On the date of the violation alleged in this complaint, respondent did not hold a certificate of public convenience issued by this Commission.

3. That respondent, on September 13, 2001, transported the household goods of Diane Zentz for \$1,738.50 compensation from New Oxford, Adams County, Pennsylvania to Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania.

4. That respondent, on September 15, 2001, transported the household goods of Diane Zentz for \$1,997.75 compensation from Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania to Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania.

5. That respondent, on November 20, 2001, transported the household goods of Robert Dean for \$5,750.00 compensation from Hanover, York County, Pennsylvania to Lancaster, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.

6. That respondent, in performing the acts described in Paragraphs 3, 4, and 5 of this complaint, violated the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §1101, in that respondent transported the household goods of Diane Zentz and Robert Dean, respectively, for compensation between points in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania while not then holding a certificate of public convenience issued by this Commission. Due to previous complaints against respondent for the same type of violation, the penalty is accelerated to \$1,000.00 per violation, for a total penalty of \$3,000.00.





A. *You must file an answer within twenty (20) days of the date of service of this complaint.* The date of service is the mailing date as indicated at the top of the Secretarial cover letter for this complaint and notice, 52 Pa. Code §1.56(a). An answer is a written explanation of circumstances wished to be considered in determining the out come. The answer shall raise all factual and legal arguments that you wish to claim in your defense and must include the reference number of this complaint. Your answer must be verified and the original and three (3) copies sent to:

B. *If you fail to answer this complaint within twenty (20) days, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety will request that the Commission issue a Secretarial Letter imposing a penalty.*

C. *You may elect not to contest this complaint by paying the fine proposed in this complaint by certified check or money order. Payment must be made to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265. Your payment is an admission that you committed the alleged violation and an agreement to cease and desist from further violations. Upon receipt of your payment, the complaint proceeding shall be closed.*

D. *If you file an answer which admits or fails to deny the allegations of the complaint, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety will request that the Commission issue a Secretarial Letter imposing a penalty (sec B).*

E. *If you file an answer which contests the complaint, the matter will be assigned to an administrative law judge for hearing and decision. The judge is not bound by the optional fine set forth in C, above.*


