COMPLAINT

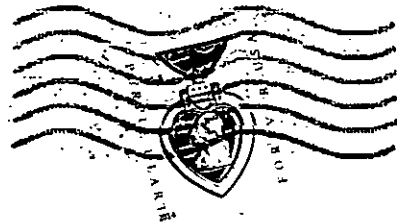
The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement Prosecutory Staff hereby represents as follows:

1. Scranton Transportation, LLC t/a Yellow Cab of Lackawanna, Respondent, maintains its principal place of business at 1102 South Main Avenue, Scranton, Pennsylvania, 18504.
2. That Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission on August 19, 2014 at Application Docket No. A-2012-2303837 authorizing transportation of passengers in taxi authority.
3. That on September 25, 2015, PUC Enforcement Officer Thomas Kepping met with owner Mrs. Mercedes Adames and began an annual safety inspection at Respondent's office that continued through several days since Mrs. Adames did not have all records at that location. The following violations were discovered during the safety inspection:
 - (a) Two drivers, Dominick Giannone and Mike Abbott, operated a taxi before the criminal history report was received.
 - (b) Driver Daniel Smith operated a taxi on September 21 and September 22, 2105 at which time his license was under suspension.
4. That Respondent, in permitting two drivers to operate prior to obtaining a criminal history record, violated 52 Pa. Code §29.505(a). The penalty for this violation is \$100 per violation, for a total of \$200.
5. That Respondent, by permitting a driver to operate a vehicle two days while driver's motor vehicle license was under suspension, violated 52 Pa. Code §29.502 and Pa. Code 75 §1543(a). The penalty is \$200 per violation, for a total of \$400.
