Dear Respondent:

On August 6, 1998, the Bureau of Transportation and Safety instituted a complaint against Marianne Industries, Inc., respondent, alleging:

"That on May 20, 1998, Pittsburgh District Enforcement Officer James Kazmarek received a letter from Rosie B. Amsler, President of Marianne Industries, Inc., stating that her company does not utilize its household goods portion of its certificate of public convenience authority. Ms. Amsler further stated that her company's business is now restricted to property moves and has discontinued household goods service."

The complaint specified that, if the respondent filed an answer which admitted the allegations in the complaint or which failed to specifically deny the allegations in the complaint, this Commission would be empowered to enter an order which either revoked or suspended any certificate held by respondent or which imposed a fine or any other appropriate penalty or remedy authorized by the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq.

An answer was filed by respondent on August 24, 1998 which admitted the allegations in the instant complaint and respondent further averred that it does not use this portion of its certificate of public convenience and will not contest the Commission's complaint.

Therefore, the complaint is sustained.

The portion of respondent's certificate of public convenience at A-00109648, F. 2, Right 25, which grants the right to transport household goods is hereby revoked.

Respondents shall cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§101, et seq., and the Regulations of this Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1, et seq.
